**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS
FOR THE ALLOCATION TO STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
FOR THE ACQUISITION OF ANNUAL TPER - BOLOGNA TRAVEL PASSES FOR THE
2021/2022 ACADEMIC YEAR**

**RESTRICTED TO STUDENTS ENROLLED IN FIRST-, SECOND- AND SINGLE-CYCLE
DEGREE PROGRAMMES**

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS: 07/09/2021 – time: 3 p.m.

As part of the actions taken to promote sustainable mobility in urban areas, TPER S.p.A. and Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna have entered into an agreement that provides for financial assistance to help students purchase travel passes.

More specifically TPER will charge students of the University € 180.00 for annual travel passes for use on urban and suburban public transport in zones 1-3.

The University will provide a further **grant** to a maximum of 5000 students selected through this call for applications who will be able to purchase the abovementioned travel pass for € **99.00**.

Art. 1. Quantity and value of the grants available

For the 2021/2022 academic year, up to a maximum of 5000 enrolled students will be offered a discount of € 81.00 on the cost of their personal TPER travel pass for travel in and around the city of Bologna in zones 1- 3.

Successful applicants will be able to purchase the abovementioned travel pass for € 99.00.

PLEASE NOTE: In order to use the grant, students must purchase the travel pass after receiving notification that they have been successful in this competition. Those who have previously purchased the travel pass at the full price will not be eligible to receive this grant.

Art. 2. General requirements for admission to the benefit

In order to obtain this grant, students must be enrolled for the 2021/2022 academic year in a first- or second-cycle degree programme or a single-cycle degree programme at the Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna on the application deadline date and on the date of purchasing the discounted travel pass. Enrolment will therefore be checked at both times.

Art. 3. Deadlines and procedures for submitting applications

The deadline for the submission of applications is **07/09/2021 at 3 p.m.**

Applications to participate in the call must be **submitted by the closing date exclusively via the “Studenti Online” application.**

To use the application:

1. access studenti.unibo.it using the SPID credentials;
2. click on the “calls for applications” button;

3. select the “Call for applications for the allocation to students of the university of financial assistance for the acquisition of annual TPER - Bologna travel passes for the 2021/2022 academic year. Enrolled in 1st, 2nd and single cycle degree programmes”

International non-EU students who cannot apply for SPID credentials can use University username and password.

NOTES:

- a. The application will be deemed valid only if the student completes the above procedure correctly;
- b. It is important to check all the contact details indicated
- c. It is not possible to submit the application in paper format or by email.

PLEASE NOTE: The information about the application visible on “Studenti Online” (e.g. "Domanda inserita") does not mean that the applicant fulfills all the participation requirements. The offices will check all the application after the expiry of the deadline

Art. 4 Procedure for accessing the benefit

Each candidate will be notified of the outcome of the application by email sent to the university email address (nome.cognome@studio.unibo.it).

Successful applicants may proceed directly, through Studenti Online, to purchase the TPER - Bologna urban and suburban zones 1-3 travel pass at the price of € 99.00 by and no later than 7/12/2021.

If there are fewer than 5000 eligible students, the deadline for submitting applications may be extended by further calls for applications.

Art. 5 Formulation of the ranking list

If, following expiry of this call for applications, the number of eligible students exceeds 5000, the University will rank the candidates in ascending order in respect of the ISEE value calculated for benefit purposes in relation to the right to Higher Education.

Preference will be given, under the same conditions, to students who are eligible for or have been awarded an ER.GO grant.

PLEASE NOTE: In order to submit the ISEE, log on using your SPID credentials to the "Online Services" section of the ER.GO website and fill in the "Dati personali" (Personal details) and "Dati economici" (Economic data). International non-EU students who cannot apply for SPID credentials can use University username and password. The "Economic Data" section requires the Self Certification (DSU) registration number obtained from INPS, which is needed to obtain the ISEE. International students who cannot request the ISEE can find detailed information about how to submit the documentation for the calculation of their economic status on the University website at the following link www.unibo.it/documentitasse.

N.B. In the event it is necessary to draw up a ranking list, applicants who have not submitted the ISEE or documentation to calculate their economic status - in the case of international students - as indicated above, will be given a strict deadline of ten days to provide said information, failing which, they will be excluded from the competition.

NOTE: Submission of the ISEE and/or documentation needed to check economic status for the purposes of this call is also valid for the calculation of the tuition fee payable on enrolment for the 2021/2022 academic year.

Art. 6 Communications

All University communications to students applying for the grant will be deemed validly sent if sent to their institutional email addresses (name.surname@studio.unibo.it).
