

International mobility grant to support the exchange mobility of regularly enrolled firstyear GIOCA students at the partner site Carnegie Mellon University of Pittsburgh for the academic year 2024/2025

DEADLINE: May 15th, 2025

IMPORTANT: The Italian language version of this act is prevailing with regard to the exact interpretation of the rules contained within.

The Master's degree in GIOCA awards 2 scholarships to students regularly enrolled in the first year of the Master's Degree Program in Innovation and Organization of Culture and the Arts in the a.y 2024/25 to support the international mobility of a regularly enrolled first-year exchange student at the partner site Carnegie Mellon University during the first semester of the second year (August-December 2025).

The scholarships are intended as a partial financial aid to the expenses related to the exchange mobility at the Carnegie Mellon University, in the amount of **EUR 1.700.00 each.** This contribution is incompatible with any Erasmus grants and/or other contributions provided by the University of Bologna for the same purpose in the same period (August-December 2025). The payment of the scholarship will be paid in one Instalment by the Administration of the Department of Management

1. SELECTION PROCESS

The committee will evaluate the merit given by the weighted average of the marks of profit of the exams of GIOCA first year. The 30 cum laude will count as 30 in the calculation of the weighted average.

Grants will be awarded according to the order of the ranking list until they are exhausted In the case of equal merit between two or more students, priority will be given to the youngest.

2. APPLICATION

To apply for this scholarship, students must register on Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it), attaching the following:

- Notice of selection by the partner location (mail)
- Draft of the MAM-GIOCA learning agreement
- Transcript of records with list of exams

Application deadline: May 15th, 2025



3. FINAL RANKING AND ACCEPTANCE

The final ranking of the winners will be published on Studenti Online and will be valid for 6 months from its approval.

Within 10 days after the notification of the ranking, the winners of the scholarship must send via email to didatticascaravilli.gioca@unibo.it a statement that he/she accepts the scholarship.

In case a student renounces the scholarship, the Selection Committee will decide whether to give the scholarship to the other students in the ranking.

4. PAYMENT METHOD FOR THE SCOLARSHIP

The payment will be made:

- via bank transfer to an IBAN account within the SEPA area in the name of the student;
- via bank transfer to the IBAN associated with prepaid, reloadable, personalized cards in the student's name:
- via bank transfer to an account outside the SEPA area in the student's name, with fees borne by the beneficiary.
