

CALL FOR STUDY GRANTS TO PREPARE THE FINAL THESIS ABROAD MASTER'S DEGREES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATISTICAL SCIENCES BOLOGNA CAMPUS

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Grants are reserved to:

- 1) Near-graduates of the following Master's degrees offered by the Dept. of Statistical sciences at Bologna campus:
 - Greening Energy Market and Finance Code 5885
 - Quantitative Finance Code 8854
 - Statistica, economia e impresa Code 8876
 - Statistical sciences Code 9222
- 2) (secondarily) Recent graduates (graduated since no more than 6 months) in the aforesaid degrees. Graduates' researches must be aimed at publishing a scientific article about the thesis topic.

DEADLINES AND GRANTS AMOUNT

The call opens on March 18, 2024. The deadline to apply is 30/04/2024.

Grants will be assigned for research projects lasting more than 3 months and no more than 6, only on-site.

The research period must start at least 60 days, and no more than 8 months, after each deadline. e.g. your mobility must start after June 30, 2024 and within December 31, 2024.

The call provides for 4 grants, transferred in one instalment within the administratively required time, possibly before departure. Amount varies according to the geographical destination:

- € 2.000 (before university and students tax obligations) for member states of the Council of Europe
- € 3.000 (before university and students tax obligations) for non-member states the Council of Europe

Any leftovers will be allocated through a following call.

Recent graduates' grants will be reduced by € 1,04 because of insurance coverage.

The scholarship is **incompatible** with other UNIBO grants awarded in relation to the same period and the same aim (prohibition of double funding).

ASSESSMENT AND RANKINGS

The Board will assess, in order of **priority**:

- 1) Research/Study project;
- 2) Study records. Only credits earned and registered within the deadline of each intake will be counted. Please notify the Board via the indicated e-mail address should you have a personalised study plan.

The maximum score is 100 points. 60 points is the minimum score to be included in the rankings. In case of tied places, the youngest age prevails. Recent graduates' projects will be evaluated in the second place.

Eligible candidates will not receive a grant but may still be authorised to carry out their research abroad. The authorisation will guarantee insurance coverage and recognition of the activity in the UNIBO records.

and no later than:

APRIL 30, 2024 at 13:00

WHAT TO UPLOAD

Applicants **must** submit the following documents via Studenti Online - failure to comply will result in exclusion from the rankings.

- **CURRICULUM VITAE** signed and dated.
- ALLEGATO A signed and duly filled in every part.
 - → Enclosed to Allegato A: back-and-front copy of a valid ID.
- RESEARCH PROJECT INFO SHEET signed (template provided in MS Word format).
- STATEMENTS

Written statement by UNIBO supervisor highlighting the relevance of the mobility abroad to carry out the research project.

→ Enclosed to the statement by the UNIBO supervisor: Written statement OR e-mail of acceptance/invitation by the foreign institution/foreign referent person mentioning a mobility period that is coherent in with the provisions of the Call. There are no templates for these statements.



Please note that UNIBO will not send any institutional nomination.

Grant holders and eligible candidates will be able to download a certificate attesting that they are entitled to leave according to the call.

ACCEPTING THE GRANT & WHAT TO DO NEXT

Rankings will be published a few weeks after the deadline of each intake.

Winners will also be informed via e-mail by <u>didatticasociale.mobility@unibo.it</u> at their institutional address <u>name.surname@studio.unibo.it</u>. They will have to **send back the provided acceptance documents within 10 working days**. Failure to comply will be considered a rejection of the grant.

Both grant holders and eligible candidates can get full recognition of the activities carried out abroad.

The mobility will be managed through the AlmaRM platform (https://almarm.unibo.it).

They will be informed via e-mail by <u>didatticasociale.mobility@unibo.it</u> about what to do. Following those instructions is compulsory in order to get full recognition of the activity carried out abroad and to maintain the grant received.

If the mobility period is not carried out, the grant must be returned.

Both grant holders and eligible candidates will be asked to state the end of their mobility through the AlmaRM platform within 30 days since the end of the mobility, and in any case within max 10 days before the deadline for fulfilling graduation requirements.

Any grant holder or eligible candidate who wishes to withdraw must promptly inform didatticasociale.mobility@unibo.it via e-mail.

Should any impediments to the regular use of the scholarship arise after accepting (e.g. maternity, serious and documented illness), the person concerned will still maintain the right to receive the grant. In this case, the person concerned shall promptly inform didatticasociale.mobility@unibo.it via e-mail providing adequate documentation. The grant amount will be paid once the impediment is over.
