

International mobility grant to support the exchange mobility of regularly enrolled first-year GIOCA students at the partner site Carnegie Mellon University of Pittsburgh for the academic year 2023/2024

DEADLINE: JULY 22nd, 2024

IMPORTANT: The Italian language version of this act is prevailing with regard to the exact interpretation of the rules contained within.

The Master's degree in GIOCA awards **1** scholarship to a student regularly enrolled in the first year of the Master's Degree Program in Innovation and Organization of Culture and the Arts **to support the international mobility of a regularly enrolled first-year exchange student at the partner site Carnegie Mellon University during the first semester of the second year (August-December 2023).**

The scholarship is intended as a partial financial aid to the expenses related to the exchange mobility at the Carnegie Mellon University, in the amount of **EUR 2,500.00.** This contribution is incompatible with any Erasmus grants and/or other contributions provided by the University of Bologna for the same purpose in the same period (August-December 2024).

The payment of the scholarship will be paid in one Instalment by the Administration of the Department of Management

SELECTION PROCESS

The Committee will assess **the merit** given by the weighted average of the marks of profit. The 30 cum laude will count as 30 in the calculation of the weighted average.

Grants will be awarded according to the order of the ranking list until they are exhausted In case of equal merit between two or more students, priority will be given to the youngest.

- 1. Notice of selection by the partner location (mail)
- 2.draft of the MAM-GIOCA learning agreement
- 3. Transcript of records with list of exams

FINAL RANKING AND ACCEPTANCE

The final ranking of the winners will be published ONLINE.

Within 10 days after the notification of the ranking, the winners of the scholarship must send via email to cdl.gioca@unibo.it a statement that he/she accept the scholarship.

In case a student renounces the scholarship, the Selection Committee will decide whether to give the scholarship to the other students in the ranking.
