

Call for Applications – Selection for Study Abroad Mobility at CAFA – School of Arts Administration and Education (SAAE), Beijing, for Students Enrolled in the Second Year (a.y. 2025/2026) of the Master's Degree Programme in Innovation and Organization of Culture and the Arts (GIOCA)

ART.1 - Aims and general admission requirements

The call for applications is addressed to students who are regularly enrolled in the 2025/2026 academic year in the second year of the Master's Degree Programme in Innovation and Organization of Culture and the Arts (GIOCA), as provided for the agreement between CAFA and the Management Department of the University of Bologna as following: Central Academy of Fine Arts, Beijing (CAFA), School of Arts Administration and Education (SAAE), Beijing

Available spots

Maximum 4 GIOCA students outgoing

Mobility grant (if any)

At this stage, no financial contributions are available to support mobility.

The possible allocation of contributions will be subject to the availability of funds allocated for the 2026 fiscal year to support student services by the Department of Management, and to the student's placement in an eligible position in the ranking resulting from any further selection procedure.

Duration

From a minimum of one term to a maximum of one academic year. As agreed with the partner site, from March 2026 on

The purpose of this call is to create a ranking list for the allocation of the mobility exchange places at CAFA – School of Arts Administration and Education (SAAE) of Beijing.

ART.2 - Mobility arrangement

Selected students:

- May attend courses pre-approved by the GIOCA Director, chosen from the catalogue of English-taught courses available at the host University. The training activities regularly carried out will be recognized in the student's career at the end of the mobility period, based on what is certified in the *transcript of records* issued by the partner University CAFA. The training activities will be delivered in English.
- Each student will be required to pay her/his travel costs and will purchase at their own



expense medical insurance, which conforms to requirements established by the host school for incoming international students.

- Students pay tuition fees at their home University and will be responsible for financing their programs.
- All further organizational information concerning the conduct of the activities will be communicated to the winners directly by the partner universities where the students will be appointed as exchange students in mobility.

ART. 3 - Participation Requirements

To be eligible for selection, you must be duly enrolled for the academic year 2025/2026 in the second year of the Master's degree course in Innovation and Orgabnization of Culture and the Arts (GIOCA).

Successful students are required to finalize their enrolment for the academic year 2025/2026 before the start of the mobility.

ART. 4 - Selection and ranking criteria

The ranking will be drawn up based on the **weighted average and CFUs obtained by the deadline of this notice**. In the event of a tie, priority will be given to the youngest candidate. This will be followed, in the event of non-acceptance and/or withdrawal, by the students in the subsequent positions. ART. 5 - Submission of the application

The application for participation in the call for applications will be made on Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it), by accessing the section "CALLS" and selecting "Call

for Applications – Selection for Study Abroad Mobility at CAFA – School of Arts Administration and Education (SAAE), Beijing ".

The only document required is a **motivational letter** (half-page), since the Transcript of Record is automatically downloaded from Studenti OnLine.

ART. 6 - Commission

Students who have submitted their applications by the date referred to in Article 5 will be selected by an Assessment Board, consisting of Paolo Ferri (Chair), Maria Lusiani (Secretary and Member), Rebecca Levy Orelli (Member). All the members of the Course Councils are substitutes.

ART. 7 - Publication of the ranking list and acceptance



The ranking established by the Committee will be published on the website: https://bandi.unibo.it/ starting from 21st November 2025.

Within five days from the date of receipt of the place assignment email, the student must send a declaration of acceptance by institutional email to the address: didatticascaravilli.gioca@unibo.it, under penalty of forfeiture.
