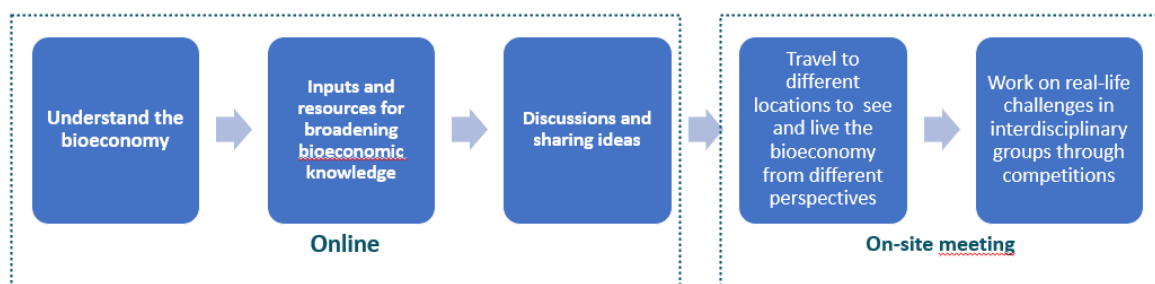

The EBU label is a common qualification supplement offered by the six EBU partner universities. By obtaining the EBU label, you will be recognized as a professional with the right knowledge and skills to shape the transformation towards a sustainable bioeconomy; moreover, you will be able to upgrade your disciplinary expertise by incorporating inter- and transdisciplinary, cross-sectoral collaboration and sustainability competences.

The **EBU student Journey** consists of a series of activities specially designed for the master students to become the professionals that are needed for the transformation towards a bioeconomy. This involves the acquisition of academic knowledge as well as soft-skills in an international context. Competences and skills that the students will develop through the EBU Journey are intended to be aligned with the labor market needs, such as the identification of new opportunities, interdisciplinarity, systemic thinking, among others.

The journey will take place once per year. During the journey, 36 students (6 master students of each EBU partner) will take part of a digital and on-site journey.



During the on-site part of the journey, the students will meet within 5 days in one of the EBU partner's location and work in interdisciplinary teams in different activities, among which a bioeconomy challenge.

The online part of the next EBU Student Journey will take place from March to June 2023.





The on-site part of the Journey will take place from the 12 to 16 June 2023 at the University of Reims, Bazancourt-Pomacle biorefinery (CEBB – European Center of Biotechnology & Bioeconomy), in Paris (France).

REQUIREMENTS

The call is open to students

- 1) regularly enrolled for the A.Y. 2022/2023 in the following agreed bioeconomy-relevant master programs:
 - Master in Low Carbon Technologies and Sustainable Chemistry (cod. 9246)
 - Analisi E Gestione Dell'ambiente / Master in Environmental Assessment and Management (cod. 8418)
 - Scienze e Gestione della Natura / Master in Sciences and management of nature (cod. 9257)
 - Master in International Horticultural Science (cod. 8883)
 - Scienze e Tecnologie Agrarie / Master in Agricultural sciences and technologies (cod. 9235)
 - Ingegneria per l'ambiente e il territorio / Master in Environmental Engineering) (cod. 8894)
- 2) with an adequate English language proficiency;
- 3) already pre-registered to the EBU label programme (see at <https://european-bioeconomy-university.eu/education/ebu-label/>)

Admission requirements must be satisfied before the deadline of this call.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications must be submitted by 9.02.2023, h 12:00 ONLY by the web platform “Studenti online” (SOL).

In order to submit their applications, applicants must:

1. Access “Studenti Online” <https://studenti.unibo.it/>.
2. Click on “Calls” (bandi).
3. Select the call: “**Call for applications - EBU Student Journey 2023**”.
4. Upload the required documents properly signed and completed **in PDF format**.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The examining commission is composed as follows:

The examining commission will proceed on the basis of the following criteria:

Motivation and interest	0-40
Non -compulsory activities (at the university, voluntary work, etc.)	0-30
Teamwork	0-20
Projection in career (connection of the journey with academic and professional perspectives)	0-10

Interview for all the eligible applicants is on 16.02.2023 via Teams (an e-mail including the time of the interview and the meeting link will be sent to applicants before the session).

FINAL RANKING

The examining commission will select n. 6 students. The final merit ranking will be viewable by candidates within the "Online Students" (SOL) application by 28.02.2023.

COSTS

The University of Bologna, through the Erasmus+ funds, covers the travel costs, accommodation and most of the meals, for each student selected to participate in the Journey the EBU Label project foresees the expenses for. Selected students will be notified about costs not covered by the University.
