**Teaching activities**: Teaching and training activities in the field of Adult Neurology in Medicine and Surgery degree programmes, in Specialisation Schools and in Professional Master's programmes. Coordination of activities and development of innovative teaching methods for students of Medicine and Medical Specialisation degree programmes with reference to the neurophysiological study of sleep, autonomic variables, and motor and behavioural activity in adult neurological diseases, also in relation to healthy ageing.
