# Art. 1 Selection procedure to be filled by mobility

The selection procedure is hereby announced to fill **1** full professor position to be filled through **mobility** pursuant to of Article 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater, of Law no. 240 of 2010 and of the University Regulations issued by R.D. no. 2069 of 21.12.2022, as reported below:

### TEACHING, RESEARCH AND THIRD MISSION ACTIVITIES TO BE MET BY THE PROJECT ACCOMPANIED BY RELATED MOTIVATION

#### **TEACHING ACTIVITIES**

The need to increase the programme catalogue for subject group M-FIL/06 in order to improve the quality of teaching, in particular to promote greater awareness among philosophy students of the importance of historical knowledge for their preparation

#### RESEARCH ACTIVITY

The aim is to promote the recovery of the importance of the historical dimension of human processes in view of their philosophical understanding and, to this end, delve into the blossoming period of debate between philosophy and history in order to analyse the origin of those concepts (first and foremost the concept of progress) that made the encounter between the two disciplines possible. Fundamental to this will be a return to the philosophical reflection on history as it was produced in the 18th and 19th centuries, and in particular its development in the German language area, which was destined to exert a great influence on European and particularly Italian culture. To be analysed with special attention will be, in this general context, the relationship with political and religious phenomena, first and foremost those linked to the incipient democratisation and secularisation of society, which constitute the distinguishing trait, once again debated today, of our so-called 'western' world. The broad temporal and spatial categories normally described through the dualisms between antiquity and modernity and East and West are to be analysed in their specific function for the philosophical characterisation of progress.

#### THIRD MISSION ACTIVITIES

Contributing to widespread awareness of civic engagement on topics that are today at the centre of public debate, first and foremost in relation to the motivations presented now as dialogue now as a clash of civilisations.

#### PROJECT EVALUATION CRITERIA

- Congruence of the project proposal:
- congruence of the project proposal with the teaching, research and third mission activities expressed by the academic department.
  - Clarity, completeness and feasibility of the project proposal:
- clarity, completeness and feasibility of the project proposal, also in terms of its impact on the needs of the academic department as set out in this call in terms of teaching, research and third mission activities and the possible degree of interdisciplinary integration with other scientific fields represented at the same academic department.
- Level of competence and scientific qualification of the candidate level of competence and scientific qualification of the candidate for the implementation of the project proposal, documented in the candidate's CV.

#### Art. 2

### Admission requirements for the mobility procedure

- 1. The following persons may participate in the mobility procedures:
- a) full professors, with at least five years of service on the deadline of the procedure, at other universities in the category corresponding to the one being advertised;
- b) scholars permanently engaged abroad in research or teaching activities, who has held an equivalent academic position in foreign universities for at least five years on the deadline of the procedure, on the basis of the equivalence tables set out in Ministerial Decree No. 662 of 1



September 2016 and subsequent amendments;

- c) research managers or first researchers in public research bodies or researchers on a permanent contract, or on a fixed-term contract pursuant to Article I, paragraphs 422 et seg. of Law no. 205 of 27 December 2017, of the Scientific Institute for hospitalisation and health care (IRCCS) which carry out translational, pre-clinical and clinical research, provided that they have been in service for at least five years at the date of expiry of the procedure at the institution to which they belong and possess the national scientific qualification for the competition sector and the category to which the mobility procedure refers.
- 2. Candidates shall meet the requirements laid down by the regulations in force for aspiring Committee members for the national scientific qualification procedures referred to in Article 16 of Law 240 of 30 December 2010. The university issuing the selection procedure is responsible for ascertaining that the above-mentioned requirements are met.

For the purposes of checking that these requirements are met, the attainment of the threshold values identified by ANVUR for the competition sector to which this call refers for at least two of the three indicators will be ascertained for each candidate.

### Indicators and Threshold Values for Competition Area 11/C5 - HISTORY OF PHILOSOPHY

- 29 Articles published in ANVUR scientific journals and Class A journals in the competition area covered by the call and contributions published in the 10 years preceding the deadline of this procedure;
- 5 Articles published in Class A journals in the competition area covered by the call in the 15 years preceding the deadline of this procedure;
- 2 Books published in the 15 years preceding the deadline of this procedure.

For the purpose of calculating the indicators, the ANVUR lists updated on the date of the deadline of the procedure will be taken into account.

Indicators and threshold values for the Competition Area covered by this procedure are set out in Annex B (Declaration concerning the possession of the requirements for Members of the National Scientific Qualification Boards).

- 3. Applicants who, at the time of submitting their application, have a degree of kinship or affinity up to and including the fourth degree with a professor of the Department that seeks to fill a vacancy or of the entity making the call or with the Rector, the Director General or a member of the Board of Governors of the University, may not take part in the mobility selection.
- 4. If the procedure provides for the performance of clinical care activities as an integral part of the teaching and research activities, the candidate must confirm that he or she meets the additional requirements pursuant to the applicable agreement. Said requirements are indicated in the relevant job description given in art. 1 of this call for applications. The requirements pursuant to the applicable agreement must be met by the deadline for submitting the application. In the event that the requirements for performing clinical care activities include a degree and a specialisation degree, and one or both of them were obtained abroad, the candidate must indicate in their curriculum vitae that they have obtained the statement of equivalence pursuant to Article 38, paragraph 3 of Legislative Decree 165/2001.



- 5. The candidate must meet the requirements provided for by this article by the deadline for submitting the application.
- Any subsequent changes affecting the requirements for participation must be notified promptly to the Office for Lectureship Competitions.
- 6. Candidates are accepted on a provisional basis. By reasoned decision, the Rector may exclude applicants from the procedure at any time for failing to meet the relevant requirements.

### Online application

1. Applications to participate in the mobility selection must be submitted online, under penalty of exclusion, using the dedicated IT application available at the following link:

https://pica.cineca.it/unibo/mobordrif1604/2023/

- 2. This is the only valid method to submit applications and the documents considered useful to participate in the selection procedure.
- 3. Participation in the selection is only possible after self-registering with the system using an email account, which does not need to be a certified email account.
- 4. The candidate must enter all the information required to prepare the application and attach the related documents in PDF format. The application form must be completed in full, as specified by the online procedure.
- 5. The online application allows the documents in draft mode to be saved up until the deadline for submitting the application. Please note: The "draft" status does not indicate submission of the application. In order to confirm that they wish to proceed with the application, candidates must ensure that the status of their application is "submitted". Therefore, only applications showing the "submitted" status by the relevant deadline will be considered for the purpose of participating in the procedure and consequently sent to the Committee to be assessed. The date of online submission of the application is certified by the IT system, which issues a receipt that is sent automatically to the candidate via email upon submission of the application.
- 6. After completing the application and adding all the relevant attachments, the candidate must ensure that they click on "submit". Completion of the application process will be indicated by the change in the application status, which will switch from "draft" to "submitted". On completing the application process, the candidate will receive an automatic email confirming submission of their application.
- 7. After the deadline for submitting the application, the system will no longer allow the electronic form to be accessed or submitted.
- 8. The application must be prepared and submitted online by and no later than 11.59 p.m., Italian time, on the thirtieth day following that of publication of the call for mobility applications on the University website.

Each application will be assigned an identification number that, together with the competition code indicated by the IT application, must be specified in all subsequent communications.

### Art. 4 Declarations to be made to participate in the mobility procedure

- 1. Candidates, aware of the criminal penalties for making false declarations or preparing or using false documents, as referred to in Article 76 of Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28 December 2000, must indicate and/or provide the following in their applications:
  - Department, competition sector and subject group for which they apply;
  - Declaration of consent to the processing of their personal data and authorisation to use said data:
  - Their personal identification and contact details;
  - Their qualifications as needed to participate in the selection. In particular, the candidate must indicate that they meet the subjective requirement, among those provided for in Article 2, paragraph 1, which allows admission to the procedure, including the further requirements, if any, pursuant to the applicable agreement;
  - Declarations regarding their enjoyment of civil and political rights in their home country, and regarding any criminal convictions and/or pending criminal trials or proceedings;
  - Declaration regarding any degree of kinship or affinity up to and including the fourth degree with a professor of the Department that seeks to fill a vacancy or of the entity making the call or with the Rector, the Director General or a member of the Board of Governors of the University.
  - That they agree to notify the Office for Lectureship Competitions about any subsequent changes with regard to meeting the requirements to participate in the procedure;
  - Declaration of status regarding military obligations (only for male Italian citizens).
  - Declaration regarding any removal or dismissal from employment with a Public Administration for persistent poor performance, or declaration that they have never been dismissed from public employment pursuant to Article 127, paragraph 1, point d) of the Consolidated Act governing the Statute of Civil State Employees, approved by Presidential Decree no. 3 of 10 January 1957, or that they have never been dismissed for disciplinary reasons, including those specified in Article 21 of Legislative Decree 29/93;
  - Declaration regarding their knowledge of Italian;
  - Declaration regarding periods of involuntary suspension from research activities, with particular reference to the performance of parental duties;
  - Declaration accepting the methods of disclosure and publication of the documents related to the procedure;
- 2. The following must be attached to the application to participate in the procedure:
  - a) Photocopy of a valid ID document;
  - b) The curriculum (in either Italian or English). The curriculum vitae, duly signed and dated, must contain a declaration in lieu of certification, pursuant to Articles 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree 445/00, confirming possession of all the qualifications indicated therein. If the call for applications provides for the performance of clinical care activities under specific agreements, the candidate's curriculum vitae must confirm that he or she meets the additional requirements pursuant to the applicable agreement. The University has prepared a CV template to facilitate assessment by the Committee, which is available on the University website (https://bandi.unibo.it/docenti/procedure-di-mobilita-per-la-chiamata-di-professori-di-i-e-ii-fascia) together with this call for applications;



- the project proposal drawn up by the candidate to meet the specific teaching, research, third mission requirements and, where foreseen, care activities, using the model in Annex A). (Annex required under penalty of exclusion)
- d) the declaration concerning the fulfilment of the requirements laid down for the Committee Members of the most recent national scientific qualification round (ASN 2021-2023) with reference to the specific indicators and threshold values of the competition sector for which the application is made, using the form in Annex B). (Annex required under penalty of exclusion)

# Art. 5 Withdrawal of candidates from the procedure

1. Candidates may withdraw from the selection procedure by sending an email to the Office for Lectureship Competitions at the address <a href="mailto:apos.concorsidocenti@unibo.it">apos.concorsidocenti@unibo.it</a>, attaching a signed declaration in PDF format and a photocopy of a valid ID document.

# Art. 6 Selection procedure.

- 1. The projects submitted by the candidates shall be evaluated by a Commission appointed by the Rector in accordance with the procedures set out in the following Article.
- The Committee evaluates the project proposals submitted by the candidates on the basis of the criteria established by the Department and set out in Article 1 of this call.
- 2. The committee evaluates the projects in relation to the teaching, research and third mission requirements expressed by the Department in the role request resolution.
- 3. At the end of its work, the Committee draws up a ranking list of the projects submitted, listing only those projects that have been assessed as coherent with the needs expressed by the Department. The ranking list can only be used to fill the post(s) to which the selection procedure refers. If the Committee assesses that no project meets the needs expressed by the Department in the call for applications, no candidate will be appointed.
- 4. The Committee completes its work within two months of appointment. The Rector may postpone the deadline to complete the procedure by reasoned decision at the request of the Chair of the Committee, only one time and by up to 30 days. If the documents related to the procedure are not delivered by the deadline to complete it, the Rector will dissolve the Committee and appoint a new one to replace it at the proposal of the Department.
- 5. If the Rector discovers irregularities in the conduct of the procedure, he sends the documents to the Committee with a motivated decision, assigning it a deadline to make any changes.
- 6. The selection procedure documents are approved by Rector's Decree within thirty days of their delivery to the office.

### Art. 7 Project Evaluation Committee

The Committee is appointed by the Rector in accordance with the provisions of Article 8 of the University Regulations governing mobility through the selection of Full and Associate professors pursuant to Article 7, paragraphs 5-bis, 5-ter and 5-quater, of Law no. 240 of 2010.



The Committee identifies a chairman and a secretary from among its members. It conducts its work in the presence of all its members and passes resolutions by an absolute majority of its members. It may use online tools to hold meetings.

# Art. 8 Recruitment procedure

1. Within 60 days from the approval of the documents, the call proposal is resolved by the Departmental Board that requested the role to be covered.

The Department will proceed to call the candidate whose project has been placed first in the ranking list by the Committee as it best meets the teaching, research and third mission requirements expressed by the Department on the basis of the criteria set out in the call for applications.

The call proposal is submitted, having obtained the opinion of the Academic Senate, for approval by the Board of Governors, which decides within thirty days.

- 2. In the event that the Department does not adopt any resolution within the time limits set forth in paragraph 1, the call proposal may also be formulated directly by the Academic Senate, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors in accordance with the procedures set forth in paragraph 1.
