

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR 3 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MERIT FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE SECOND YEAR OF THE MASETR'S DEGREE IN AEROSPACE ENGINEERING ALMA MATER STUDIORUM UNIVERSITÀ DI BOLOGNA

A.Y. 2022-2023

DEADLINE: 14 MARCH 2023 at 12.00 p.m.

ART.1 Object, amount and duration:

A Call for Applications for 3 scholarships for merit has been published. The scholarships, **1.085,00 € (Euro)** each (gross amount) are reserved to students regularly enrolled in the second year for a.y. 2022-2023 of the master's degree in Aerospace Engineering- Forlì Campus.

Exclusion from the call is applied to the following categories of students: students who enrolled in years subsequent to the first, passages and transfers (art. 3, 13, 14 of the Student Regulations, D.R. 464/2013).

Each scholarship is awarded for one year only and cannot be renewed.

ART.2 Incompatibility

The scholarship for merit of this call for applications cannot be combined with scholarships/awards awarded for the same aim by the University of Bologna (the rule also applies to Unibo Action 2 and Unibo for Refugees), nor with scholarships for merit issued by ER.GO, by the Ministry of the Foreign Affair and International Cooperation (MAECI), by the Collegio Superiore of Bologna and by CRUI for students with international protection (for the amount related to meals).

ART. 3 Requirements

In order to participate to the call for applications, students must meet all the following requirements (failing to do so will result in the exclusion from the call for applications):

- 1) to have enrolled on the master's degree in Aerospace Engineering for the first time in a.y. 2021-2022 and **to be regularly enrolled** on the second year of the same master's degree in Aerospace Engineering in a.y. 2022-2023;
- 2) to have passed at least 54 CFU/ECTS by March 14th 2023;
- 3) to be under 30 years old by the deadline of the call for applications;
- 4) not to have incurred in any disciplinary sanctions.

ART.4 Award criteria and Evaluation Commission

The Evaluation Commission, nominated by Managerial Decree, made up of Dott.ssa Giulia Chiadini, Prof. Fabrizio Giulietti, Prof. Enrico Troiani (supply members- Dott. Ing. Dario Modenini and Dott.ssa Annalisa Ercolani) will draw up a ranking list based on the numbers of credits obtained by the participants of the call for applications. Should there be candidates with equal number of credits, priority will be given to the highest weighted average. In case of further equality, priority will be given to the youngest candidate.



ART.5 Application submission

To apply, candidates must submit their applications by March 14th 2023, at 12.00 p.m. (CET) exclusively through Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it)

In order to apply, candidates must:

- login at <u>www.studentionline.it</u> by using their Unibo credentials;
- click on "Call for applications";
- select the call for applications "Call for applications for 3 grants aimed at students enrolled on the second year of the Master's degree in Aerospace Engineering for 2022/2023 a.y."

The system will automatically verify the enrolment requirement and, in case of positive feedback, will allow the student to continue the application.

PLEASE NOTE

We would like to remind candidates that only regularly registered credits (with either a mark or pass) will count. Modules of integrated courses will not count for in the total credits gained by the candidate.

The application is valid only if the candidate correctly completes the procedure. It is not possible to submit the application in paper form, nor via email nor fax.

The Administration may carry out checks on the truthfulness of what has been declared. Without prejudice to the penalties provided for by art. 76 of Presidential Decree 445/2000, if the untruthfulness of the content of the declarations provided emerges from the check, the declarant will lose the scholarship even after the assignment of contributions.

ART.6 Acceptance

The final merit ranking will be approved with provision of the Manager of the Campus Area of Forlì-ACFO.

The awarded students will receive specific communication, exclusively by sending an e-mail to the institutional postal address (name.surname@studio.unibo.it), on the formalities necessary for the payment of the scholarship. Suitable candidates will be notified of the ranking on SOL.

Awarded candidates who, after the grant acceptance, cannot go abroad for personal reasons, must give written communication as soon as possible to didatticaforli.ing@unibo.it.

Within the mandatory term of 5 days from the date of the scholarship awarding communication, the recipient must send the declaration of acceptance of the scholarship, without reservations, via e-mail to didatticaforli.ing@studio.unibo.it and under the conditions of the competition announcement. Failing to do so will result in exclusion from the scholarship. The recipient of the scholarship must also give explicit assurance, under his own responsibility, that he will not run into the incompatibilities envisaged by art. 2 of this announcement and undertake to communicate any variation, which may occur in the year with respect to what was declared.

Successful candidates will be notified of the ranking.



ART.7 Scholarship payment

Payment of the scholarship will be made by bank transfer to a current account or prepaid card with an Italian IBAN in the name or joint name of the beneficiary student.

Art.8 Withdrawal

Withdrawal from the call for applications must be communicated via e-mail to didatticaforli.ing@studio.unibo.it. In the event of withdrawals received within 30 days of publication of the ranking, the scholarship will be assigned to the next suitable candidate in the ranking. In case of transfer to another degree course during the A.Y. 2022/2023, the winner will be considered withdrawn and therefore, will have to return the full amount of the scholarship. The withdrawing scholarship holder, except for the proven existence of serious and justified reasons, will be required to repay any sums already received.
