31 students will be selected to participate to an International crisis management Simulation (NATO Model Event)

organised in cooperation with
NATO Allied Commander Transformation HQ

NOVEMBER 5th, 6th, 7th 2023

1. OBJECT

The Department of Political and Social Sciences, in partnership with *NATO Allied Commander Transformation HQ (ACT HQ)*, organizes an annual simulation of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization in the form of a NATO Model conference. The 15th NATO Model event is scheduled for November the 5th, 6th, 7th 2023.

It is a complex simulation activity that will involve 31 selected students who will be asked to “decide how to act” as representatives of the North Atlantic Council member countries in the event of a serious international crisis. This simulation model developed by NATO is considered an outstanding practical tool for students to gain an understanding and put into practice what they have learnt on the role of diplomacy in international relations.

The NATO Model Event will be performed in English and it will involve 31 students, 18 out of them will be selected amongst students enrolled in the following University of Bologna degrees:

- MA International Relations (Bologna)
- MA Local and global development (Bologna)
- MA International and Diplomatic Sciences (Forlì)
- MA Interdisciplinary Research and Studies on Eastern Europe - MIREES (Forlì)
- BA International and Diplomatic Sciences (3rd year students) (Forlì)
- MA Mass media and Politics (Forlì)
- MA International Politics and Markets (Forlì)
- MA International Politics and Economics (Forlì)

The 13 students enrolled in other Italian or foreign Universities will be selected by the students’ home Universities.

The participation does not award any university credit (CFU/ECTS).



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2. OBJECTIVES

The International NATO Model is designed to:

- Share a deeper knowledge amongst NATO member countries citizens on the Atlantic Alliance, its mission and current role as well as on its adaptation to the changing security environment both at the global and at the regional level.
- Support the creation of a NATO network including NATO staff, experts, academics and motivated students to foster knowledge at university level and to promote exchanges between the academia and political decision makers as well as with the wider network of partner institutions;
- Contribute to training participants to develop negotiating skills on NATO key issues;
- Award a UNIBO-NATO ACT Joint Diploma to the 31 participating students having profitably completed the assignments given in the framework of the Simulation;
- Promote a joint effort to set best practices in Higher Education on NATO, its mission, politics and partnerships;
- Promoting the development of a new generation of experts and practitioners in transatlantic relations, committed both to scientific research and in the achievement of the key values of the Washington Treaty.

The implementation of the activities is conditional on the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding which is in process of being renewed.

3. REQUIREMENTS

Applications are accepted from:

- students enrolled in the Academic Year 22/23 or 23/24 in the 3rd year (including those who are beyond the prescribed time) of the Bachelor Degree International and Diplomatic Sciences (L-SID);
- students enrolled in the Academic Year 22/23 or 23/24 in one of the Master's Degree listed in point 1 of the present Call for Application.



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4. ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND REQUESTED DOCUMENTS

Submit your application on **Studenti Online before October 6th, 2023 at 12:00 (CET)**.

1. Log in on Studenti Online using your institutional login and password;
2. Click on “BANDI”/Call for application;
3. Select NATO Model event Call for application

Please upload online the following mandatory documents in .pdf format:

1. Curriculum vitae;
2. Transcript of records
 - a. the transcript is automatically retrieved by the system for University of Bologna students and graduates;
 - b. students enrolled in the 1st year of one of the above-listed Master’s degree are requested to upload a self-certification/Transcript of records showing the final graduation mark of the previous academic studies, the Evaluation Committee will consider the graduation mark converted into a mark out of 30.

The system will automatically verify whether the requirements set in point 3. are met and it will allow continuing the application procedure.

PLEASE NOTE:

- The application is valid only if the candidates complete the-above mentioned procedure and attach any relevant document;
 - The application cannot be sent by e-mail nor handed in on paper.
- a) Italian and European citizens can certify their academic and professional titles according to art. 46 and 47 of the D.P.R. 445/2000.
 - b) Non-EU citizens who are regularly resident in Italy shall act in accordance with art. 2, paragraphs 2 and 3 of the D.P.R. 445/2000.



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- c) Beyond the above-mentioned a) and b) cases, the status, personal details and facts and shall be certified by the issuing authority in the foreign country accompanied by a certified translation into Italian or English and be aware of any legal consequences in case of false certificates or statements.

The University of Bologna reserves the right to make controls of its own on the truthfulness of the information provided.

5. SELECTION CRITERIA

The Evaluation Committee is composed of the following Professors:
Matteo Dian, Lorenzo Zambernardi, Carmelo Danisi.

The **selection** will be based on the following criteria:

- **Interview** (spoken English proficiency in discussing issues regarding international politics and security, with specific reference to NATO will be assessed) up to 30 points;
- **Academic performance*** (weighted average) or Bachelor Degree final exam grade/GPA for 1st year students (*for 1st year students who have not graduated yet, the weighted average of the previous academic studies will be considered) up to 20 points;

The **Interview** will take place online via Microsoft TEAMS.

The interview is scheduled for October 12th at 09:00.

Eligible candidates will receive a formal appointment by email.

Failure to attend the interview at the time and place scheduled will result in being excluded from the selection.

The minimum score to be considered eligible is 40 points.

In the event of candidates with equivalent score, priority will be given according to the younger candidate.

The Evaluating Committee will draw up a ranking list based on merit, priority will be given to students who are citizens of a NATO member Country.
