GENERAL INFORMATION

As defined by the Cooperation Agreement between the University of Bologna (UNIBO) and the Tongji University (Attachment 1):

- no more than 20 students from each partner university per academic year can benefit from the Agreement.
- to participate in the Double Degree Program students are selected by their home university, according to its own criteria and modalities, and their admission is approved by the host partner university, according to its own requirements.
- no Chinese students enrolled at the University of Bologna are admitted to take part in the Dual Degree Programme.

GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To apply for the Double Degree Programme 2019/2020 students must be enrolled in the first year of the Master degree in Engineering of Building Processes and Systems 8890), international curriculum Historic Buildings Rehabilitation – HBR (640), in the Academic Year 2018-19.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Ravenna Campus funds three scholarships of 4,600 euro each. Scholarships are not meant to cover all the expenses, but are to be intended as a contribution towards the major expenses related to the stay (and therefore as an incentive to promote international mobility).

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

In order to apply for the Double Degree Program the following documents are requested:

- application form (Attachment 2), duly completed and signed;
- copy of the Degree Certificate with final grade;
- Transcript of records or a self-certification of the exams passed during the first semester of HBR programme (you can download this certification at the following web-site https://studenti.unibo.it/sol/welcome.htm);
- English Language Certificate stating a B2 CEFR level (see Attachment 3);
- a motivation letter (to be written in English);
- a copy of your ID card/Passport or other valid identity document.
