

Abstract for Call for application for 2 scholarships addressed to graduates of the second cycle degree Programme in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development (RESD)

(The Italian language version of the act is prevailing with regard to the exact interpretation of the rules contained within, also in case of potential disputes).

ART. 1 – Subject

The Head of the Ravenna and Rimini Campus, Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna offers offers 2 scholarships to students of the second cycle degree programme in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development enrolled in the academic year 2020/2021 who have graduated in the academic year 2021/2022 for the amount of € 1.500,00 (gross taxes) for the first ranked and of € 1.200,00 (gross taxes) for the second ranked for the best degree thesis.

ART. 2 – Admission requirements

The application is open exclusively to graduates meeting the following requirements:

- matriculation in RESD in the academic year 2020/2021;
- graduation in the second cycle degree programme in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development in the academic year 2021/2022 within the regular duration of the course (by 15^{th} June 2023 as extraordinary session a.y. 2021/2022 Rectoral Decree Rep. N. 316/2023, Prot. N. 0062200 del 07/03/2023);
- minimum final grade 110/110.

ART. 3 – Evaluation criteria

The scholarships will be assigned by the evaluation Committee: professors Anna Montini, Elettra Agliardi, Corrado Benassi (substitute any professor of the degree programme).

The evaluation will be based exclusively on merit requirements:

- **final thesis** (quality and authenticity of the thesis, methods of research and analysis, results obtained) max 15 points;

- final grade:

110/110 = 3 points

110/110 cum laude = 5 points

Minimum score: 15/20.

In case of a tie between two or more candidates in the ranking list, the benefit will be granted to the youngest applicant.

ART. 4 – Incompatibility

The scholarship is incompatible with other scholarships or grants with the same aims and in the same period.

ART. 5 Application procedure

The online application shall be submitted within 6th November 2023 – 12 pm (CET) on "StudentiOnline". In order to apply, the candidate shall:

- 1. log in www.studenti.unibo.it with the Unibo account username and password;
- 2. select the button "bandi" (call for applications);

Documents required for the application (or the application will be invalid):

- 1) pdf copy of the final thesis;
- 2) self-certification of the master's degree with final mark and transcript of records of exams passed from "studenti on line",
- 3) copy of the identity card or passport.

Without prejudice to the penal sanctions laid down in article 76 of Italian Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445/2000, in the event of fraudulent information being discovered as a result of such verification, the applicant will forfeit the right to the benefit.

Italian and EU citizens can provide self-certification of professional and academic qualifications, according to articles 46 and 47 of DPR 445/2000.

Non-EU citizens must conform to art. 3.2 and 3.3 of the DPR 445/2000.

The office disclaims any responsibility in case of misplaced delivery or misunderstanding. Applications sent after the deadline will not be accepted.

ART. 6 - Acceptance

Selected candidates shall confirm their acceptance of the grant within 10 days from official notification, sending their declaration of acceptance duly signed according to indications received by campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it, or the assignment shall be invalid.

ART. 7 – Information notice concerning data processing
