Abstract for Call for application for 2 scholarships addressed to graduates of the Second cycle degree Programme in Business Administration and management – curriculum Service management (SEM)

(The Italian language version of the act is prevailing with regard to the exact interpretation of the rules contained within, also in case of potential disputes).

ART. 1 – Subject

Following the disposition of the Head of the Ravenna and Rimini Campus of the University of Bologna, the Alma Mater Studiorum — University of Bologna offers 2 grants to graduates of the second cycle degree Programme in Business Administration and management — curriculum Service management (SEM) in the academic year 2019/2020 for the amount of € 1500,00 (before tax) for the first in the ranking list and of € 1000,00 (before tax) for the second in the ranking list, for the best degree thesis

ART. 2 – Admission requirements

The application is open exclusively to graduates meeting the following requirements:

- regular enrolment in the second year for the academic year 2019/2020;
- graduation in the Second cycle degree Programme in Business Administration and management curriculum Service management in the academic year 2019/2020 on due time (by 28th May 2021 as extraordinary session a.y. 2019/2020);
- minimum final grade 110/110.

ART. 3 - Evaluation criteria

The grants will be assigned by the evaluation committee, as proposed by the decree D.D. Rep. n. 7544/2020 Prot. n. 291359 tit. III cl. 12 fasc. 100 del 3/12/2020: professors Marco Visentin, Leonardo Corbo, Giulia Baschieri..

The evaluation will be based exclusively on merit requirements:

- **final thesis** (quality and authenticity of the thesis, methods of research and analysis, results obtained) max 15 points;
- final grade:

110/110 = 3 points
110/110 cum laude = 5 points

Minimum score: 15/20.

In the event of equal score, the benefit will be granted to the youngest applicant.

ART. 4 – Incompatibility

The scholarship is incompatible with other scholarships or grants with same aims and in the same period.

ART. 5 Application procedure

Applicants shall submit:

- 4) copy of the identity card or the passport.

Applications sent after the deadline will not be accepted.

Italian and EU citizens can provide self-certification of professional and academic qualifications, according to articles 46 and 47 of DPR 445/2000.

ART. 6 - Acceptance

Selected candidates shall confirm their acceptance of the grant within 10 days from official notification, sending declaration of acceptance duly signed according to indications received, or the assignment shall be invalid.

ART. 7 – Information notice concerning data processing
