

ABSTRACT OF THE CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR 8 STUDY GRANTS ADDRESSED TO STUDENTS ENROLLED IN ECONOMICS OF TOURISM OR CURRICULUM IN INTERNATIONAL TOURISM AND LEISURE INDUSTRIES OR TOURISM ECONOMICS AND MANAGEMENT

(This English abstract is just for publicity purposes. For any application and/or dispute resolution and/or for any legal purpose only the Italian version must be taken into consideration)

Art. 1 Subject

The head of the Rimini and Ravenna Campus of the Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna offers 8 study grants of the amount of € 420,00 each (gross of all charges for the beneficiary's account), as partial contribution for 8 students who will be attending the Accept Project week about "*Overtourism*", that will take place from 10 November to 16 November 2019 at Breda University of Applied Sciences, Breda – the Netherlands (https://accept.jimdo.com/accept-2019-the-netherlands/).

No CFU will be assigned.

The preparatory activities for the Project Week will be held *weekly* starting from the beginning of the teaching activities (first cycle first semester), coordinated by Prof. Lorenzo Zirulia.

The grant will cover the registration fees at the organizing University. Grant holder will be required to pay with a bank transfer within the deadline that will be notified to the participants, also to cover expenses for any material necessary for the project week.

This registration fee **is inclusive of**: accommodation in low budget hotel/youth hostel; local transport during the excursions; all the meals – but 1; use of material to prepare the assignments in the host country; attending the programme.

It does **not include** transport to and from the host country (the Netherlands).

Art. 2 Eligibility

Applicants shall meet the following requirements:

1. Be enrolled for the academic year 2018/2019 to the first cycle degree programme in Economics of Tourism or Curriculum in International Tourism and Leisure Industries or the second cycle degree programme in Tourism Economics and Management,

Candidates who will get their degree by the date of the Project Week will not be admitted to the selection process.

- 2. have 45 CFU by the deadline of this call for applications,
- 3. not having participated in the previous ACEEPT Project Weeks.

Art. 3 Application procedure

All candidates shall apply with unstamped papers, according to application form as Annex 1, to be delivered at:

Art. 4 Selection procedure

Based on merit (academic results and cv) and interview.

Evaluation criteria:

- Merit and CV: max 40 points
- Interview: max 60 points

Applicants shall reach min. 60/100 points to be accepted.

The Interview will be in English and will take place **13 September 2019 starting at 10:00am** in the room Angherà 3 of the School of Economics, Management and Statistics – Rimini, in order to test the language knowledge and the motivation in the project. All candidates shall show a personal ID. **Absent candidates will be excluded from the selection.**

Candidates may ask for an alternative off-site interview method (to be held on the same date) via Skype, to be specified in the Application Form.

ART. 5 Results

Results will be available on the web site of each degree programme.

The scholarships will be assigned as follows:

-4 for the second cycle degree TEAM

-2 for the first cycle degree CLET, international curriculum ITALI

-2 for the first cycle degree CLET.

In case of less candidates for each degree course, all the scholarships will be assigned to the other degree courses according to the rankings.

Those successful candidates who renounce for any reason will have to provide written and timely information in order to allow replacement with a reserve candidate.

The grant will be transferred upon presentation of the receipt of payment of the bank transfer to the Breda University of Applied Sciences, Breda – the Netherlands and of transport tickets, together with annex 3.

Art. 6 Acceptance of the grant

Selected candidates need to confirm acceptance of the grant within 10 days from official notification, sending Annex 2 duly signed, or the assignment shall be invalid.

Art. 7 Withdrawal

Those successful candidates who renounce for any reason will have to provide written and timely information in order to allow replacement with a reserve candidate.
