

Abstract of the Call for Applications for 2 grants addressed to students enrolled in the first and second year of Resource Economics and Sustainable Development for the participation to the Annual Conference of the European Association of Environmental and Resource Economists.

ART. 1 - Subject

The Head of the Rimini Campus, Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna offers 2 grants of € 800 (before tax) to students enrolled in the first or second year of the second cycle degree Resource Economics and Sustainable Development (RESD) to attend the Annual Conference of the European Association of Environmental and Resource Economists in Limassol (Cyprus) 27 - 30 June 2023. (https://www.eaere.org/)

The whole amount of the grant will be paid in a single instalment before departure.

Within one month after the conference, the beneficiary will have to submit to the Degree Programme Director a short report and a declaration released by EAERE on attendance, otherwise the scholarship must be refunded.

ART.2 – Beneficiaries

Beneficiaries are students regularly enrolled in the first or second year of the second cycle degree in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development for the a.y. 2022/2023.

ART. 3 - Application procedure

The online application shall be submitted by **12 pm of 21 April 2023** (CET) on "StudentiOnline". In order to apply, the candidate shall:

- 1. log in www.studenti.unibo.it with the Unibo account username and password;
- 2. select the button "bandi" (call for applications);
- 3. select the relevant call for applications.

The application will be valid exclusively in case the applicant has completed the above mentioned procedure and has attached all the required documents.

No documents will be accepted when either sent via email or via regular mail, handed in or sent after the deadline.

Documents required for the application (or the application will be invalid):

- 1. motivation letter in English for attending the conference signed;
- 2. self-certificate with transcript of records (studentionline);
- 3. curriculum vitae in English;
- 4. copy of identity card or passport.



Without prejudice to the penal sanctions laid down in article 76 of Italian Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445/2000, in the event of fraudulent information being discovered as a result of such verification, the applicant will forfeit the right to the benefit.

ART. 4 – Evaluation

A list of qualified applicants will be drawn up by the evaluation committee upon merit and motivations: the Committee will prioritise motivation over merit.

In the event of equal points, priority will be given to candidates with a lower family income, according to the Authority for the Right to Higher Education.

ART. 5 – Assignment

The Evaluation Committee appointed by the Head of Rimini Campus of University of Bologna - D.D. Rep. n. 1784/2023 Prot. n. 0077043 tit. V cl. 5 del 21/03/2023 is composed by professors Anna Montini, Alessandro Tavoni, Corrado Benassi (supplemented by a professor of the degree program).

The successful applicants will be defined by the Evaluation Committee and the results will be available on the websites http://bandi.unibo.it.

The selected candidate shall confirm acceptance of the grant within 10 days from official notification to <u>campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it</u> The candidate will receive instructions on how to fill in the formal acceptance declaration and the fiscal form.

The winner must also communicate the date of departure and return, so that adequate insurance coverage is guaranteed for the entire period.

ART. 6 – Withdrawal

The beneficiaries who, for any reason, waive the contribution shall give written notification in due time, in order to allow the replacement of candidates.

ART. 7 - Privacy

The personal data provided shall be processed by the Alma Mater Studiorum – Università di Bologna Via Zamboni n. 33, 40126 Bologna in compliance with the principles and provisions of Italian Legislative Decree n. 196/2003 (Data Protection Act) and the European Law GDPR UE n. 2016/679 and in any case exclusively for the purposes of this call for applications.
