Abstract of the Call for Applications for 3 grants for the participation to the 27th Annual Conference of the European Association of Environmental and Resource Economists in Rimini (RESD)

ART. 1 - Subject

The Head of the Ravenna and Rimini Campus, Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna offers 3 grants of € 373.50 (before tax) to attend the 27th Annual Conference of the European Association of Environmental and Resource Economists Rimini 28th June – 1st July 2022 (<https://www.eaere.org/>).

The whole amount of the grant will be paid in a single instalment.

Within one month after the conference, the beneficiary will have to submit to the Degree Programme Director a short report and a declaration released by EAERE, otherwise the scholarship will be refunded.

ART.2 - Beneficiaries

Beneficiaries are students enrolled in the first or second year of the second cycle degree in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development (RESD) for the a.y. 2021/2022.

ART. 3 - Application procedure

The online application shall be submitted within **15th June 2022 - 12pm (CET)** on “StudentiOnline”.

In order to apply, the candidate shall:

1. log in www.studenti.unibo.it with the Unibo account username and password;
2. select the button “bandi” (call for applications);
3. select the call for applications “Bando per l’attribuzione di 3 borse di studio per la partecipazione alla 27esima conferenza annuale EAERE Rimini (RESD)”.

The application will be valid exclusively in case the applicant has completed the above mentioned procedure and has attached all the required documents.

No documents will be accepted when either sent via email, via regular mail, handed in or sent after the deadline.

Documents required for the application (or the application will be invalid):

- motivation letter in English dated and signed;
- self-certificate with the transcript of records (studentionline);
- curriculum vitae in English dated and signed;
- copy of the identity card or the passport.

Without prejudice to the penal sanctions laid down in article 76 of Italian Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445/2000, in the event of fraudulent information being discovered as a result of such verification, the applicant will forfeit the right to the benefit.

ART. 4 - Evaluation

A list of qualified applicants will be drawn up by the evaluation committee on the basis of academic merit and motivation letter:

- a) motivation letter: personal motivation will prevail on academic merit;
- b) self-certificate with the transcript of records (the evaluation committee will take into consideration only the credits registered within the application deadline);
- c) CV.

In the event of equal points, the benefits will be granted to the youngest applicant.

ART. 5 – Assignment

The members of the evaluation committee, appointed by the Head of Ravenna and Rimini Campus, will be Professors Anna Montini, Alessandro Tavoni, Corrado Benassi. The list of qualified applicants will be available on the web page <http://bandi.unibo.it>

Selected candidates will have to confirm acceptance of the grants within 10 days from official notification to the email address: campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it or the assignment shall be invalid, sending a declaration of acceptance duly signed and the fiscal form received via email.

ART. 6 – Withdrawal

The beneficiaries who, for any reason, waive the contribution shall give written notification in due time, in order to allow the replacement of candidates.

ART. 7 - Privacy

The personal data provided shall be processed by the Alma Mater Studiorum – Università di Bologna Via Zamboni n. 33, 40126 Bologna in compliance with the principles and provisions of Italian Legislative Decree n. 196/2003 (Data Protection Act) and the European Law GDPR UE n. 2016/679 and in any case exclusively for the purposes of this call for applications.
