

Abstract of the Call for Applications for 2 grants addressed to students enrolled in Business economics - curriculum Financial and business management (FINMA) for the Summer school ISCTE Business School in Lisbon

(This abstract is translated to English just for publicity purposes. For any application and/or dispute resolution and/or for any legal purpose only the Italian version must be taken into consideration)

ART. 1 – Subject

The Head of the Rimini Campus, Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna offers 2 grants of € 2.150 each (before tax) to students regularly enrolled in the first year of the bachelor degree Business economics - curriculum Financial and business management (FINMA) for attending the Summer school ISCTE Business School in Lisbon 23 July – 12 August 2023 (<u>https://ibs.iscte-iul.pt/contents/programas/1552/summer-school-lisbon</u>)

The whole amount of the grant will be paid in a single instalment before departure.

Within one month after the Summer school, the beneficiary will have to submit to the Degree Programme Director a declaration released by ISCTE on attendance of one of the courses indicated at point 3 of this call, otherwise the scholarship must be refunded.

ART.2 – Beneficiaries

Beneficiaries are students regularly enrolled in the first year of the bachelor degree Business economics - curriculum Financial and business management (FINMA) for the a.y. 2022/2023.

ART. 3 - Application procedure

The online application shall be submitted by **12 pm of 18 April 2023** (CET) on "StudentiOnline". In order to apply, the candidate shall:

1. log in www.studenti.unibo.it with the Unibo account username and password;

2. select the button "bandi" (call for applications);

3. select the relevant call for applications.

The communication pertaining to the call will be sent on the institutional ID of the student @studio.unibo.it.

The application will be valid exclusively in case the applicant has completed the above-mentioned procedure and has attached all the required documents.

No documents will be accepted when either sent via email or via regular mail, handed in or sent after the deadline.

Documents required for the application (or the application will be invalid):

- motivation letter in English for attending the Summer School, specifying the chosen course among the following: • Cross Cultural Communication and Negotiation • Financial Risk Management • International Business;
- 2. self-certificate with transcript of records from studentionline (credits registered by the application deadline will be taken into consideration);
- 3. curriculum vitae;
- 4. copy of identity card or passport.



Without prejudice to the penal sanctions laid down in article 76 of Italian Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445/2000, in the event of fraudulent information being discovered as a result of such verification, the applicant will forfeit the right to the benefit.

ART. 4 – Evaluation

A list of qualified applicants will be drawn up by the evaluation committee upon merit and motivations: the Committee will prioritize motivation over merit.

In the event of equal points, priority will be given to candidates with a lower family income, according to the Authority for the Right to Higher Education.

ART. 5 – Assignment

The Evaluation Committee appointed by the Head of Rimini Campus of University of Bologna is composed by professors Selena Aureli, Francesco Maria Barbini, Massimiliano Barbi (supplemented by a professor of the degree program).

The successful applicants will be defined by the Evaluation Committee and the results will be available on the websites <u>http://bandi.unibo.it</u>.

The selected candidate shall confirm acceptance of the grant within 10 days from official notification to <u>campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it</u> The candidate will receive instructions on how to fill in the formal acceptance declaration and the fiscal form.

ART. 6 – Withdrawal

The beneficiaries who, for any reason, waive the contribution shall give written notification in due time, in order to allow the replacement of candidates.

ART. 7 – Recognition

For recognition purposes, at the end of the experience winner shall send to campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it confirmation by ISCTE Business School of attendance and participation to the chosen course. 6 credits will be recognized to winners in the relevant scientificdisciplinary field as extra credits (exceeding the 180 necessary for graduating).

ART. 8 - Privacy

The personal data provided shall be processed by the Alma Mater Studiorum – Università di Bologna Via Zamboni n. 33, 40126 Bologna in compliance with the principles and provisions of Italian Legislative Decree n. 196/2003 (Data Protection Act) and the European Law GDPR UE n. 2016/679 and in any case exclusively for the purposes of this call for applications. The data will be processed using electronic and manual (paper) methods. The Data Controller is the University of Bologna – Rimini Campus.
