

**Abstract** of the Call for Applications for 2 grants addressed to students enrolled in the second cycle degree in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development for the participation to the IAERE conference (Italian Association of Environmental Resource Economists).

# ART. 1 – Subject

The Head of the Rimini Campus, Alma Mater Studiorum — University of Bologna offers 2 grants of € 450 each (before tax) to students enrolled in the second cycle degree Resource Economics and Sustainable Development (RESD) to attend the IAERE conference (Italian Association of Environmental Resource Economists) that will take place in Trento, from the 12<sup>th</sup> to the 13<sup>th</sup> of February 2026.

Within one month after the conference, the beneficiary will have to submit to <a href="mailto:campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it">campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it</a> a short report and a declaration released by IAERE on attendance, otherwise the scholarship must be refunded.

## ART.2 - Beneficiaries

Beneficiaries are the following students:

- a) Students that were regularly enrolled, in the a.y. 2024/25, to the first year of the second cycle degree in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development and that are regularly enrolled, in the a.y. 2025/26, to the second year of the second cycle degree in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development;
  - -Alternatively:
  - b) Students that were regularly enrolled, in the a.y. 2024/25, to second year of the second cycle degree in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development and that didn't lose their status of students by the 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025.

## ART. 3 - Selection

All applicants must upload in the application a detailed letter written in English explaining their reasons and motivations for participating in the conference. A list of qualified applicants will be drawn up by the evaluation committee upon merit and motivations: the Committee will prioritize motivation over merit. In the evaluation of merit, the credits and grades actually recorded by 30<sup>th</sup> September will be taken into account.

In the event of equal points, priority will be given to younger candidates.

### **ART. 4 - Application procedure**

The online application shall be submitted by **12 pm of 30**<sup>th</sup> **September 2025** (Italian time) on "StudentiOnline".

In order to apply, the candidate shall:

- 1. log in www.studenti.unibo.it with the Unibo account username and password;
- 2. select the button "bandi" (call for applications);
- 3. select the relevant call for applications.

The application will be valid exclusively in case the applicant has completed the above-mentioned procedure and has attached all the required documents.

No documents will be accepted when either sent via email or via regular mail, handed in or sent after the deadline.

Documents required for the application (or the application will be invalid):

- 1. motivation letter in English for attending the conference;
- 2. self-certificate with transcript of records (studentionline): the credits and grades actually recorded by 30<sup>th</sup> September will be taken into account.
- 3. copy of identity card or passport.

Without prejudice to the penal sanctions laid down in article 76 of Italian Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445/2000, in the event of fraudulent information being discovered as a result of such verification, the applicant will forfeit the right to the benefit.

## ART. 5 – Assignment

The Evaluation Committee appointed by the Head of Rimini Campus of University of Bologna is composed by professors Anna Montini, Alessandro Tavoni, Corrado Benassi (supplemented by any professors of the degree program).

The successful applicants will be defined by the Evaluation Committee and the results will be available on the websites <a href="http://bandi.unibo.it">http://bandi.unibo.it</a>.

# ART. 6 - Acceptance

Within a peremptory deadline of ten days from the date of the formal notification of the awarding of the scholarship, the winners must send to <a href="mailto:campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it">campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it</a> under penalty of forfeiture, a declaration of unreserved acceptance of the conditions of the call for applications and the forms relating to tax and personal data that will be sent to them.

### ART. 7 – Withdrawal

The beneficiaries who, for any reason, waive the contribution shall give written notification in due time, in order to allow the replacement of candidates.

# ART. 8 – Grants Payment

The payment of the scholarships will take place from 20<sup>th</sup> November 2025, but only for the winners who, at that date, won't have submitted the graduation request (not even the belated request) and have maintained their student status.

## ART. 9 - Privacy

The personal data provided shall be processed by the Alma Mater Studiorum – Università di Bologna Via Zamboni n. 33, 40126 Bologna in compliance with the principles and provisions of Italian Legislative Decree n. 196/2003 (Data Protection Act) and the European Law GDPR UE n. 2016/679 and in any case exclusively



for the purposes of this call for applications. The data will be processed using electronic and manual (paper) methods. The Data Controller is the University of Bologna – Rimini Campus. The Data
