

Abstract of the Call for Application for the participation at the 24th ANNUAL CONFERENCE EAERE

(This abstract is translated into English just for publicity purposes. For any application and/or dispute resolution and/or for any legal purpose only the Italian version must be taken into consideration)

1. Subject

The Head of the Ravenna and Rimini Campus of the Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna, offers 1 scholarship of EUR 1,300 (before taxes) for a RESD student enrolled in the 1^{st} or 2^{nd} year of programme.

The scholarship will be a contribution to support the participation to the 24th Annual Conference EAERE which will take place in Manchester (UK) from 26th to 29th June 2019 (https://www.eaere.org/). The whole amount of the scholarship will be paid in a single instalment before departure. Within one month after the conference, the beneficiary will have to write a short report. The student's report, together with a declaration released by EARE, must be sent to the dean of RESD, otherwise the scholarship will be refunded.

2. Eligible Candidates

The scholarships will be granted in line with the terms and procedures laid down herewith. The application is open to candidates enrolled in the first or second year of RESD for a.y. 2018/19.

3. Application procedure

All candidates shall apply with unstamped papers, according to application form as **Annex A** and send/ **handle** it to:

Deadline: h 12.00 (Noon) 28th February 2019

The candidate has to verify the correct receipt of the email. The office is not responsible for any misplacement in the reception.

In case of regular mail, date of delivery will be considered and **not** the date of the sending stamp. The office disclaims any responsibility in case of misplaced delivery or any misunderstanding with post offices.

Documents required (or the application shall be invalid):

- 1. Curriculum Vitae (with date and signature)
- 2. Self-certificate with transcript of records;
- 3. Motivation letter;
- 4. Copy of ID

4. Selection criteria

The selection will be based exclusively on the following criteria:

- Academic merit (weighted average and credits acquired) up



to 60 points

- Motivation letter (up to 40 points).

5. Assignment

An evaluation committee will publish the ranking list of candidates on RESD website (www.resd.unibo.it).

The Selected candidate need to confirm acceptance of the scholarship within 10 days from official notification, sending declaration of acceptance duly signed and the fiscal form that he/she will receive via email, or the assignment shall be invalid.

6. Withdrawal

Candidates, who decide, for any reason, to withdraw the scholarship, will have to write the office, at their earliest condition, in order to select another eligible candidate.

7. Information notice concerning data processing

The personal data provided shall be processed in compliance with the principles and provisions of Italian Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 (Data Protection Act) and the GDPR UE n. 2016/679 and in any case exclusively for the purposes of this call for applications. The Administration reserves the right to verify the truth of the information provided.
