

Abstract of the call for applications for **awards for the best project work of students of the Second cycle degree Programme in Business Administration and management – curriculum Service management (SEM)**

(The Italian language version of the act is prevailing with regard to the exact interpretation of the rules contained within, also in case of potential disputes).

ART. 1 – Subject

The Head of the Rimini Campus of the Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna offers awards of \notin 250 (before tax) to each participant of the group for the best project work in the academic year 2022/2023.

The group will be chosen among the 4 groups who have taken part in the project works promoted within the courses I.C. OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS and I.C. OF CUSTOMER RELATIONSHIP MANAGEMENT under the guidance of professor Marco Visentin and Paola Giuri (as defined by the Degree Board meeting on 18th October 2022). The aim of these projects is to allow students to put into practice knowledge and skills acquired during the classes, together with enhancing team building and strengthening the partnership between companies and the university. The project works have been defined by the parties (hosting companies, professors, students) and led in the period September 2022 -February 2023.

ART. 2 – Admission requirements

The application is open to students meeting the following requirements:

- enrolment in the second year of the second cycle degree Programme in Business Administration and management – curriculum Service Management (SEM) for the academic year 2022/2023;

- attendance of the courses of I.C. OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS and I.C. OF CUSTOMER RELATIONSHIP MANAGEMENT in the academic year 2022/2023;

- participation in the project works 2022/2023;

- nomination in one of the groups of the 4 partner companies of the project works (Group 1 – Geocom: Group 2 – Maggioli; Group 3 – Museo Fellini; Group 4 – Start Romagna), as defined by the Degree Board as above.

ART. 3 - Application procedure

Applicants shall submit their application online by:

1. login on <u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>

2. Bandi – Calls

3. select the relevant call for project works

4. upload

-copy of the presentation of one's group project work. All participants of the group have to agree on the content of the presentation (containing the name of the group, the name of the company, the name of the company's responsible, the name of the other group participants);

- a copy of the passport or the identity card.

deadline: 15th March 2023, 12 pm (noon)



The administrative offices reserve the right to carry out checks on the truthfulness of the declarations. Without prejudice to the criminal sanctions provided for by art. 76 of DPR 445/2000, should the check reveal that the contents of the declaration are not true, the declarant shall forfeit the right to enjoy the grant in question.

ART. 4 – Evaluation criteria

On the 31st March 2023 at 10 am in room Alberti 10 in Via Q. Sella 13 – Rimini the groups will have to make a presentation of their project works and the results achieved to the professors of the courses I.C. OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS and I.C. OF CUSTOMER RELATIONSHIP MANAGEMENT, the companies' representatives and the evaluation committee.

A ranking list will be made according to the following criteria:

- completeness of the project;
- coherence between initial aims and results achieved;
- clarity of the presentation The minimum score to pass the selection is 18 points out of 30.

The presentation will be done in presence (students unable to be in Rimini shall ask for permission to sit the presentation online on TEAMS by writing an email to <u>cdl.sem@unibo.it</u> 3 days in advance).

ART. 5 – Assignment

The grants will be assigned by the evaluation committee: professors Marco Visentin, Paola Giuri, Giulia Baschieri, as appointed by the Head of the Ravenna and Rimini Campus. The list of qualified applicants will be available on the web page <u>http://bandi.unibo.it</u>

ART. 6 – Acceptance

Winners need to confirm acceptance of the grant within 10 days from official notification, sending declaration of acceptance to campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it or the assignment shall be invalid. They will receive instructions on how to fill in the formal acceptance declaration and the fiscal form.

ART. 7 – Withdrawal

Beneficiaries who, for any reason, waive the contribution shall give written notification at the earliest convenience.

ART. 8 – Intellectual property

By participating in this call each participant expressly declares that the project is original and does not violate in any way, either in whole or in part, the intellectual or industrial property rights of third



parties, releasing the organizers from any liability, claim for damages and / or sanction brought by third parties in this regard.

ART. 9 – Privacy
