**Call for application for one scholarship addressed to one talented second year student enrolled in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development in the ay 2017/2018, University of Bologna, Rimini Campus
DEADLINE: 28/02/2019 - h.12.00 (Italian time)**

The Italian language version of the act is prevailing with regard to the exact interpretation of the rules contained within, also in case of potential disputes.

ART. 1 – Subject

The Head of the Ravenna and Rimini Campus, Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna offers **1 scholarship for the amount of € 1,000,00 (before tax)** in order to support students enrolled in the International Second Cycle Degree Programme *Resource Economics and Sustainable Development (RESD)*.

ART. 2 – Admission Requirements

The benefit will be granted in line with the terms and procedures laid down herewith.

The application is open exclusively to candidates enrolled **in the first year in the a.y. 2017/2018, and regularly enrolled in the second year in the ay. 2018/2019.**

Only exams of the first year and acknowledged exams of the first year will be considered.

ART. 3 Application procedure

All candidates shall apply with unstamped papers, according to application form as **Annex 1** and send it via regular mail to:

Deadline: 28th February, 2019 at 12,00 (Noon)

In case of regular mail, date of delivery will be considered and **not** the date of the sending stamp. The office disclaims any responsibility in case of misplaced delivery or any misunderstanding

- Copy of the ID;

ART. 4 Selection criteria

The selection will be merit based, depending on number of credits acquired in the first year and grades obtained. Each student is awarded a score calculated as follows:

$$\text{Score} = \frac{\text{Grade exam}_1 * \text{ECTexam}_1 + \text{Grade exam}_2 * \text{ECTexam}_2 + \dots + \text{Grade exam}_N * \text{ECTexam}_N}{\sqrt{\text{ECTexam}_1 + \text{ECTexam}_2 + \dots + \text{ECTexam}_N}}$$

where ECTexam_1 and ECTexam_N is the first and last exam passed by the candidate, respectively.

The grade exam 30 e lode will value 33 points.

Seminars will not be considered for the structure of the general score.

Students are invited to double-check that all passed exams have been properly recorded.

ART. 5- Assignment

The ranking list and results will be available on the web site www.resd.unibo.it

Selected candidates need to confirm acceptance of the grant within 10 days from official notification, sending declaration of acceptance duly signed, and fiscal declaration or the assignment shall be invalid.

The contribution will be paid in one unique installment.

Those who, for any reason, waive the contribution shall give written notification in due time, in order to allow the replacement of candidates.

Art. 6 - Privacy

The personal data provided shall be processed in compliance with the principles and provisions of Italian Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 (Data Protection Act) and the European Law GDPR UE n. 2016/679 and in any case exclusively for the purposes of this call for applications. The data will be processed using electronic and manual (paper) methods. The Data Controller is the University of Bologna – Rimini Campus.
