

Abstract of the Call for applications for grants addressed to talented first year students enrolled in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development in the academic year 2020/2021

(This abstract is translated to English just for publicity purposes. For any application and/or dispute resolution and/or for any legal purpose only the Italian version must be taken into consideration)

ART. 1 - Subject

The Head of the Ravenna and Rimini Campus, Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna offers 2 grants of € 1,000 (gross of taxes) in order to support talented students enrolled in the international Second Cycle Degree Programme Resource Economics and Sustainable Development (RESD) in the academic year 2020/2021 on their first year.

ART. 2 - Beneficiaries

The application is open exclusively to candidates regularly enrolled in the first year in the a.y. 2020/2021

ART. 3 Selection criteria

The selection will be merit based, depending on number of credits acquired in the first year and grades obtained. Each student is awarded a score calculated as follows:

$$\textbf{Score} = \frac{\text{Grade exam_1*ECTexam_1+Grade exam_2*ECTexam_2+...+Grade exam_N*ECTexam_N}}{\sqrt{\text{ECTexam_1+ECTexam_2+...+ECTexam_N}}}$$

where ECTexam_1 and ECTexam_N is the first and last exam passed by the candidate, respectively. The grade exam 30 cum laude will value 33 points.

Only exams registered by the 30th April 2021 will be considered. Students are invited to double-check that all passed exams have been properly recorded.

In case of a tie between two or more candidates in the ranking list, priority will be given to the youngest.

ART. 4 Application procedure

Applicants shall submit:

- form Annex 1
- self-certificate with the transcript of records (studentionline);
- copy of the identity card or the passport.

by email as an attachment to <u>campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it</u> with the object: "Application for talented students – RESD1" (it is suggested to request the acknowledgement receipt).

Without prejudice to the penal sanctions laid down in article 76 of Italian Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445/2000, in the event of fraudulent information being discovered as a result of such verification, the applicant will forfeit the right to the benefit.

All candidates have to verify the correct receipt of the email. The office disclaims any responsibility in case of misplaced delivery or misunderstanding.

Applications sent by email after the deadline will not be accepted.



ART. 5 - Assignment

Those who, for any reason, waive the contribution shall give written notification in due time, in order to allow the replacement of candidates.

ART. 6 - Acceptance

Selected candidates need to confirm acceptance of the grant by email to <u>campusrimini.didatticaseas@unibo.it</u> within 10 days from official notification, sending declaration of acceptance or the assignment shall be invalid. They will receive instructions on how to fill in the formal acceptance declaration and the fiscal form.

ART. 7 - Privacy

The personal data provided shall be processed by the Alma Mater Studiorum – Università di Bologna Via Zamboni n. 33, 40126 Bologna in compliance with the principles and provisions of Italian Legislative Decree n. 196/2003 (Data Protection Act) and the European Law GDPR UE n. 2016/679 and in any case exclusively for the purposes of this call for applications.
