

Abstract of the Call for applications for 2 scholarships, one of which in memory of Daniele D'Agostini, addressed to talented second year student enrolled in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development in the academic year 2018/2019

ART. 1 – Subject

The Head of the Ravenna and Rimini Campus, Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna offers 2 grants of € 1,000 (before tax), one of which in memory of Daniele D'Agostini, in order to support talented students enrolled in the international Second Cycle Degree Programme *Resource Economics and Sustainable Development (RESD)* in the academic year 2018/2019 on their first year.

ART. 2 - Beneficiaries

The application is open exclusively to candidates enrolled in the first year in the a.y. 2018/2019 and regularly enrolled in the second year in the a.y. 2019/2020. Only exams of the first year and acknowledged exams of the first year will be considered.

ART. 3 Application procedure

Applicants shall submit the attached application form **Annex A** addressed to:

All candidates have to verify the correct receipt of the email. The office disclaims any responsibility in case of misplaced delivery or misunderstanding.

Applications handed in or sent by email after the deadline will not be accepted.

Documents required for the application (or the application will be invalid):

- self-certificate with the transcript of records (studentionline);
- copy of the identity card or the passport.

Without prejudice to the penal sanctions laid down in article 76 of Italian Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445/2000, in the event of fraudulent information being discovered as a result of such verification, the applicant will forfeit the right to the benefit.

ART. 4 Selection criteria

The selection will be merit based, depending on number of credits acquired in the first year and grades obtained. Each student is awarded a score calculated as follows:

$$Score = \frac{\text{Grade exam}_1 + \text{Grade exam}_2 + \text{Grade exam}_2 + \dots + \text{Grade exam}_N + \text{Grade exam}_$$

where ECTexam_1 and ECTexam_N is the first and last exam passed by the candidate, respectively. The grade exam 30 cum laude will value 33 points.



Seminars will not be considered for the general score. Students are invited to double-check that all passed exams have been properly recorded.

ART. 5 - Assignment

The ranking list and results will be available on the web site <u>http://bandi.unibo.it</u>

Selected candidates need to confirm acceptance of the grant within 10 days from official notification, sending declaration of acceptance or the assignment shall be invalid. They will receive instructions on how to fill in the formal acceptance declaration and the fiscal form.

In the event of equal points, the benefits will be granted to the youngest applicant.

The contribution will be paid in one unique installment.

Those who, for any reason, waive the contribution shall give written notification in due time, in order to allow the replacement of candidates.

Art. 6 - Privacy

The personal data provided shall be processed by the Alma Mater Studiorum – Università di Bologna Via Zamboni n. 33, 40126 Bologna in compliance with the principles and provisions of Italian Legislative Decree n. 196/2003 (Data Protection Act) and the European Law GDPR UE n. 2016/679 and in any case exclusively for the purposes of this call for applications. The data will be processed using electronic and manual (paper) methods. The Data Controller is the University of Bologna – Rimini Campus.
