Language requirements

Exchange students are requested to provide an **IELTS (Academic)** certificate with a minimum overall score of **6.5** and a minimum score of **6.0** in each section. Alternatively, Exchange students may provide a **TOEFL iBT** or **TOEFL Home Edition** certificate with a minimum overall score of **83** and a minimum score of **13** in the reading section, a minimum score of **21** in the writing section, a minimum score of **12** in the listening section and a minimum score of **18** in the speaking section. Schools or Departments open to exchange students

Exchange students are allowed to attend courses held within all fields of study, except for Medicine and Law. Exchange students are allowed to attend both undergraduate courses (codes 1000 - 3999) and postgraduate courses (codes 5000 - 6999), however, students who have not completed their Bachelor Degree (Corso di Laurea, primo ciclo) yet are not allowed to take postgraduate courses. Generally, Exchange students are not allowed to attend honours courses (codes 4000 - 4999).

Courses in Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Pharmacy, and Physiotherapy are open only to students who are enrolled at the University of Bologna in a “Corso di Laurea” or in a “Corso di Laurea Magistrale” in the same field of study.

Exchange students may be required to have completed specific courses as prerequisite. Curtin University is willing to evaluate courses with similar content taken at the University of Bologna as equivalent exams; see the document “Guidelines for Overseas study project” at the following page: www.unibo.it/en/overseas.

Language requirements

Exchange students are requested to provide a **TOEFL iBT** with a minimum overall score of **68**, with a minimum score of **21** in the writing section, a minimum score of **18** in the speaking section, and a minimum score of **13** in the listening and in the reading sections. Alternatively, Exchange students may provide an **IELTS (Academic)** certification with a minimum overall score of **6.0** and a minimum score of **6.0** in each section.

Language requirements

The University of Melbourne requires students to provide evidence of meeting the English language requirements either through a **TOEFL iBT** or **TOEFL Home Edition** certificate with an overall score of **79** (Writing 21, Speaking 18, Reading 13, Listening 13) or an **IELTS (Academic)** test with an overall score of **6.5** (with a minimum of 6.0 in each subtest).

On the institutional reporting menu of the TOEFL result, indicate under Score Recipients: **0974** for the University of Melbourne, and **7850** for the University of Bologna.

Language prerequisites may vary for graduate courses.

Schools or Departments open to exchange students

Exchange students are allowed to attend undergraduate courses held at the following Faculties: Arts & Design, Arts & Social Sciences, Built Environment, Business, Engineering, Law, and Science except for Medicine and Veterinary. Graduate courses are generally accessible only to students enrolled either in their 2nd year of a "Laurea Magistrale" or in their 5th year of a "Laurea Magistrale a Ciclo Unico", except for some courses in the fields of study of Law, Science, and Engineering.

The following courses are not open to exchange students: Faculties of Medicine and Veterinary, Australian Graduate School of Management - MBA courses; courses with the prefix "Z"; courses of Summer/Winter Session; Honours (codes 4xxx), graduate courses of Psychology, courses with the following prefix: INST, GLST, DANC, EDST, LAWS, JURD and courses coded: MARK2999, MARK3999, MARK4999, FINS3100, FINS3200, MARK6XXX, GBAT.

There are also strong restrictions on Dance courses, Online Courses and Music courses. Law courses can only be taken by students enrolled in Law.

Exchange students may be required to have completed certain courses as prerequisite. The University of New South Wales is willing to evaluate courses with similar content taken at the University of Bologna as equivalent exams; see the document "Guidelines for Overseas study project" at the following page: www.unibo.it/en/overseas.

Language requirements

The minimum is: an overall TOEFL iBT or TOEFL Home Edition score of **90** (with a minimum of **23** in Writing, and a minimum of **22** in Reading, Listening and Speaking) or an overall IELTS (Academic) score of **6.5** (with a minimum of 6.0 in each subtest). Schools or Departments open to exchange students

Exchange students are allowed to attend courses at all Faculties and Schools, with the exception of the Schools/Faculties of Clinical Medicine, Dentistry, Psychology and postgraduate Medicine.

There are also limitations for the courses in Media, Architecture, and Law. Law, Veterinary Science and Media & Communications and Pharmacy are open only to students who are enrolled in those specific degrees at the University

of Bologna. Undergraduate and postgraduate courses are open to exchange students, with the following restrictions: postgraduate courses are not open to students enrolled in a Bachelor's Degree (Laurea), the first year of a Master's Degree (Laurea Magistrale) or the fourth year (or lower) of a Single cycle Master's Degree (Laurea Magistrale a Ciclo Unico). Exchange students are not allowed to attend postgraduate courses in Medicine. Clinical Medicine courses are closed also at undergraduate level.

Students from the School of Medicine are not eligible for the programme.

Exchange students may be required to have completed certain courses as prerequisite. The University of Sydney is willing to evaluate courses with similar content taken at the University of Bologna as equivalent exams; see the document "Guidelines for Overseas study project" at the following page: www.unibo.it/en/overseas.

Language requirements

The University of Sydney requires students to show evidence of meeting the English language requirements either through a TOEFL iBT certificate with an overall score of **85** (with a minimum of 19 in Writing, and a minimum of 17 in Reading, Listening and Speaking) or through an IELTS (Academic) test with an overall score of **6.5** (with a minimum of **6.0** in each subtest). For some subject areas the requested minimum scores are higher.

As a general rule, both undergraduate as well as postgraduate courses are open to exchange students. However, postgraduate courses are not available to students enrolled in a Bachelor Degree (Laurea), or in their 1st 2nd or 3rd year of a Single-cycle Master's Degree (Laurea Magistrale a Ciclo Unico).

The following Faculties are open to exchange students: Analytics and Data Science, Business, Design Architecture and Building, Education, Communication, International Studies, Engineering, Creative Intelligence and Innovation, Information Technology, Law, Science, Sport and Exercise, Transdisciplinary Innovation. Students can also choose among the 'electives' courses.

Exchange students may be required to have completed certain courses as prerequisite. UTS is willing to evaluate courses with similar content taken at the University of Bologna as equivalent exams; see the document "Guidelines for Overseas study project" at the following page: www.unibo.it/en/overseas. Placements and Practical Subjects are not available, normally. Subjects from the following programs are generally not available to exchange students: Nursing; clinical and education placements; Midwifery; all Graduate Health subjects; Master of Clinical Psychology; MBA Executive; Chinese Medicine; Engineering internships. Animation and Media Arts Production have limited availability.
