Language Requirements

A French language proficiency level of B1 (or above) is required, as per the standards of The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Proof of language proficiency can be provided through sitting the Overseas language test at the Language Centre CLA or through a certificate (see www.unibo.it/overseas for eligible certifications and test dates).

Academic Calendar

Each Faculty establishes its own specific calendar in the framework of an academic year that starts in October and ends in August. At some Faculties (for example the Faculté de Sciences juridiques et politiques and the Faculté de Lettres et Sciences Humaines) the first semester may start between mid-November and beginning of December and ends in the month of April; the second semester starts in the month of April and may end between July and August. At others, the first semester may start already in October and ends in the month of February; the second semester may start in the month of February and ends in the month of June. **Important Notice:** the pandemic has negatively affected the academic calendar of UCAD through the last academic years delaying the beginning of activities. When planning their Overseas mobility students are invited to consider this element of uncertainty.

Accommodation

University can assist exchange students in finding accommodation. Exchange students are usually accommodated in the University residences.

Schools or Colleges open to Exchange Students

As a general rule all Faculties are available except the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, the Department of Accounting and the Faculty of Military Science. In any case, the access is bound to the final approval of the relevant Faculty at Stellenbosch University. Students can include in their Learning Agreement up to a maximum of 60 South African credits (1 CFU = 2 South African credits; this equivalence is suggested by Stellenbosch University).

Limitations

Students enrolled in the single cycle degree course in Medicine and Surgery are not eligible.

Language Requirements

A minimum score of 80 on the TOEFL IBT or TOEFL Home Edition test is required. Alternatively, a total score of 6.5 or more on the IELTS (Academic) test or a total score of 160 or more on the Cambridge (First, Advanced, Proficiency).

As a general rule all Faculties are available except the Faculty of Health Sciences. In any case, the access is bound to the final approval of the relevant Faculty at University of Pretoria. Some Faculties admit every year a limited number of international exchange students, as the Faculty of Veterinary Science does.

University of Pretoria recommends a minimum workload of 3 modules per semester.

Limitations

Students enrolled in the single cycle degree course in Medicine and Surgery are not eligible.

Language Requirements

A minimum score of **93** on the TOEFL IBT or TOEFL Home Edition test is required. Alternatively, a total score of **7** or more on the IELTS (Academic) test.
