Exchange profile 3: thesis research

The subject of their thesis must consider Argentina or South America as a relevant area for empirical research or collaboration with institutions, businesses or

local universities. Under penalty of exclusion from the programme, after being selected for the exchange and before their departure* students must submit the following documents:

- written approval of the exchange signed by their UNIBO thesis supervisor.
- written authorisation from a host supervisor (via email or letter) who is willing to welcome and supervise the student in his/her thesis research activity during the exchange.

Furthermore, selected student will have to submit a Learning Agreement in which they declare that they will be undertaking thesis research during their exchange.

*the deadline for the submission of the listed documents will be communicated by the Diri Area 3 Office.
