Exchange students are allowed to attend undergraduate and graduate level courses from the Faculty of History, Armenian Philology, Chemistry, Physics, Economics and Management, Biology, Geography and Geology, Law, Russian Philology, Oriental Studies, Journalism, Philosophy and Psychology, Sociology, European Languages and Communication, International Relations and some courses from IT Educational and Research Centre, Center of Pedagogy and Education Development, Centre for European Studies. The University offers courses in English and Russian.

Language requirements

Students who wish to attend English taught courses are requested one of the following English language certifications: TOEFL iBT or TOEFL Home Edition with a minimum overall score of 75, IELTS (Academic) with a minimum overall score of 6.5. Cambridge (First, Advanced or Proficiency) certificates with an overall score of 160 are accepted too. Students wishing to attend Russian taught courses are requested to have a knowledge of Russian equal to or higher than B1, as defined in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. This must be verified either by taking a test or by providing a language certificate. On the same page, the date set for the language test will be published.

Limitations

Courses of the Master of Science in Computer Science and Data Analytics and Master of Science in Electrical and Power Engineering are not open for exchange students. We advise to check carefully the courses offered by the university.

Language Requirements

All Exchange Students are requested to provide one of the following language certificates in English: **TOEFL IBT** with a minimum score of **75**; **IELTS (Academic)**, with a minimum score of **6.5**. **Cambridge (First, Advanced or Proficiency)** certificates with an overall score of **160** are accepted too.
