A minimum score of 71 on the TOEFL IBT or TOEFL Home Edition test is required. Alternatively, a total score of 6.0 or more on the IELTS (Academic) test or a total score of 160 or more on the Cambridge (First, Advanced, Proficiency).

Language Requirements

A French language proficiency level of B1 (or above) is required, as per the standards of The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Proof of language proficiency can be provided through sitting the Overseas language test at the Language Centre CLA or through a certificate/qualification (see www.unibo.it/overseas for eligible certifications and test dates).

Schools or Colleges open to Exchange Students

As a general rule all Faculties are available except the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, the Department of Accounting and the Faculty of Military Science. In any case, the access is bound to the final approval of the relevant Faculty at Stellenbosch University. Students can include in their Learning Agreement up to a maximum of 60 South African credits (1 CFU = 2 South African credits; this equivalence is suggested by Stellenbosch University).

Limitations

Students enrolled in the single cycle degree course in Medicine and Surgery are not eligible.

Language Requirements

A minimum score of 80 on the TOEFL IBT or TOEFL Home Edition test is required. Alternatively, a total score of 6.5 or more on the IELTS (Academic) test or a total score of 160 or more on the Cambridge (First, Advanced, Proficiency).

Limitations

Students enrolled in the single cycle degree course in Medicine and Surgery are not eligible.

Language Requirements

A minimum score of 93 on the TOEFL IBT or TOEFL Home Edition test is required. Alternatively, a total score of 7 or more on the IELTS (Academic) test.
