Call for application for 1 Visiting Position at the Department of Management

Alma Mater Studiorum University of Bologna — Department of Management (hereinafter, "DISA"), in the framework of the Project "Department of Excellence", is opening a call for application for <u>one Visiting position as follows</u> (for the description of the single profile please see the document "Towards a European Framework for Research Careers"

Profile: Established Researcher - researchers who have developed a level of independence.

Experience requested:

- Makes a positive contribution to the development of knowledge, research and development through co-operations and collaborations
- Identifies research problems and opportunities within their area of expertise
- Identifies appropriate research methodologies and approaches
- Conducts research independently which advances a research agenda
- Can take the lead in executing collaborative research projects in cooperation with colleagues and project partners
- Publishes papers as lead author, organises workshop or conference sessions

Activity to carry out:

- One seminar in the frame of the Ph.D programme focused on "Quantitative methods in tourism and hospitality"
- One "opening speech" addressed to students enrolled in tourism courses at the Rimini campus
- Research activity: Competitive enterprises need to offer products and services with a high-quality value and have to constantly adapt to the market changes. Therefore, communication channels with the external environment are fundamental to bring inside the company all information and knowledge required for facing any change. Networks among enterprises are a good example of these interrelated information chains. The research activity aims to investigate the existing collaboration networks in Rimini and their positive effects on the enterprise performances with a focus on potential mediators and on the effects of the tourist culture. Questionnaires have already been distributed and they need now to be analyzed.
 - The expert will collaborate mainly with professors Giuseppe Cappiello, Manuela Presutti and Marco Visentin.
- **Duration**: 2 weeks, between September and December 2021 according to academic calendar and Italian sanitary conditions.
- **Grant**: a grant for a total gross amount of <u>1,700 euro</u> (including all costs incurred for travel, accommodation and meals).

Language

The language to implement the activities will be Italian and English.

Assessment of applications

The applications will be assessed by a Commission appointed by the Department Board.

The selected candidate will receive a letter of invitation with all details to be signed for acceptance.

Formal Requirements for foreign Visiting Professors

The entry and residence in Italy are regulated by the Italian laws and local regulations.

It is up to the Visiting Professor to obtain VISA and any other necessary authorization to enter Italy.

The selected candidates will be requested either to have a liability coverage for the period to be spent at DISA or to pay the accident insurance policy provided by the University.

A health insurance is recommended for non-EU citizens.
