In-presence activities will take place from $\underline{22^{nd} \text{ to } 26^{th} \text{ of May } 2023}$ at MCI The Entrepreneurial School® - Innsbruck (Austria). While online activities will take place on $\underline{15^{th} \text{ and } 16^{th} \text{ of May } 2023}$ and on $\underline{5^{th} \text{ June } 2023}$.

All the activities will be hold in English, the knowledge of English required is CEFR B2.

The students that will successfully complete the programme (virtual and in-person mobility – both mandatory) will receive **4 ECTS/CFU**, which will be recognised by the Study Courses Type D activities (optional courses in the study plan).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Commission will select **5 students**. Applicants should be **regularly enrolled** in Scienze e Tecnologie Alimentari/Food science and Tecnology (LM-70) A.Y. 2022/2023 until the recognition of the 4ECTS/CFU in the career. Knowledge of English required: **CEFR B2**

Applicants should **upload** the following documents:

- Self-certification of exams taken during the study course (both 1st and 2nd cycle degree)
- Motivational letter in English (max 250 words)
- English language knowledge (minimum B2) certificates or similar documents

In case of incomplete documentation, the application will be rejected.

CRITERIA FOR THE FORMULATION OF THE RANKING

The Commission will assign the score as follows:

- Max. **50 points** for the evaluation of the academic career;
- Max. **30 points** for the motivational letter;
- Max. 20 points for English language knowledge certificates

RANKING PUBLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE

At the end of the evaluation phase, a ranking will be formulated on the basis of the scores assigned by theCommission.

Should two or more applicants obtain the same score, those with the lower age will precede.

The winners will have to accept the mobility through the ALMARM platform, according to the instructions that will be sent by the email <u>diri.erasmusbip@unibo.it</u> International Relations Area (AFORM - *Ufficio Mobilità per Studio* (BIP)).

AMOUNT OF THE FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION

According to Erasmus+ Programme, the financial contribution is established as follows:

Duration of in-person mobility	Amount
Until the 14 th day of activity	70 euro / day
From the 15 th day to the 30 th day of activity	50 euro / day

Students with fewer opportunities will receive a one-time-only extra amount of $100 \in$ to the individual support of the EU contribution for an in-person mobility from 5 to 14 days, or $150 \in$ for an in-person mobility from 15 to 30 days.

Students that will choose a "green" travel solution will receive another extra amount of 50€ one-time-only.

Further information about the financial contribution will be provided to the students that will be selected for this programme.

Erasmus+ contributions are related to the activities abroad and to the recognition of such activities by the University. Students that will not complete all the steps will have to return the whole amount of the contribution.
