

O.P. Jindal Global University (JGU) is a non-profit global university established by the Government of Haryana and recognised by the University Grants Commission (UGC). JGU was established as a philanthropic initiative of its Founding Chancellor, Mr. Naveen Jindal in memory of his father, Mr. O.P. Jindal. JGU is one of the few universities in Asia that maintains a 1:13 faculty-student ratio and appoints faculty members from India and different parts of the world with outstanding academic qualifications and experience. JGU is a research intensive university, which is deeply committed to its core institutional values

of interdisciplinary and innovative pedagogy; pluralism and rigorous scholarship; and globalism and

international engagement.

JGU has established eight schools: Jindal Global Law School (JGLS), Jindal Global Business School (JGBS), Jindal School of International Affairs (JSIA), Jindal School of Government and Public Policy (JSGP), Jindal School of Liberal Arts & Humanities (JSLH), Jindal School of Journalism & Communication (JSJC); Jindal School of Art & Architecture (JSAA) and Jindal School of Banking & Finance (JSBF). JGU achieved distinction by breaking into the global university rankings and is the Youngest Indian University to feature in these rankings. JGU has been granted with "Autonomy" by the University Grants Commission and the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, for receiving the "A" Grade from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). This makes JGU the only private university in the state of Haryana and one of the only two private universities in India to be given the status of autonomy.

JGU has been awarded the highest DIAMOND RATING by QS I-Gauge and has been ranked in the 251-300 rank bracket of the QS University Rankings: BRICS 2018 Edition. JGU is ranked in the top 300 universities out of 9,000 universities in the BRICS region (covering five countries – Brazil, Russia, India, China, South Africa), placing it in the top 2.8% of the universities in the BRICS region. JGU is also the first and only private university in Haryana to have been ranked in an international ranking. Through this recognition, JGU is ranked among the top 10 private higher education institutions in India. JGU is also recognised as the cleanest university in India by the Government of India. JGU was awarded the first rank in the 2017 Swachhta rankings of all higher education institutions in India.
