CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE AWARD OF 30 GMAT LICENSES AND 7 GRE LICENSES TO DESERVING STUDENTS IN THE SECOND YEAR OF THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAM IN ECONOMICS AND FINANCE (CLEF)

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 23rd February 2026, 1.00 pm

This is an adapted translation in English of the original Call for Applications ("Bando CLEF") in Italian and it is made only for publicity purposes. To enforce the call, resolve any dispute and for all legal purposes only the Italian version will be valid, and will prevail in the exact interpretation of the rules contained within.

Art. 1 – Recipients

The selection call is addressed to second-year students who are regularly enrolled in the Bachelor's Degree Program in Economics and Finance (CLEF) for the 2025/2026 academic year.

Art. 2 – Subject and Purpose of the Procedure

This call for applications aims to establish two ranking lists: one ranking list for the allocation of 30 GMAT (Graduate Management Admission Test) licenses and one ranking list for the allocation of 7 GRE (Graduate Record Examinations) licenses.

The licenses are intended for practice and preparation for the GMAT/GRE tests and will be granted free of charge to the selected students.

Art. 3 – Number of Licenses

The total number of GMAT licenses made available through this call is 30. The total number of GRE licenses made available through this call is 7.

Art. 4 – Admission Requirements

Applicants must, by the application deadline:

- be regularly enrolled in the 2025/2026 academic year in the second year of the bachelor's degree Programme in Economics and Finance (CLEF);
- be up to date with the payment of tuition fees for the second year of the Economics and Finance (CLEF) degree programme for the 2025/2026 academic year.

Art. 5 – Evaluation criteria and ranking procedure

The Committee will draw up the overall ranking on the basis of a total score, determined by the sum of the points awarded for the number of credits earned and the weighted average of the exam grades recorded by the application deadline.

Credits related to Additional Educational Obligations (OFA) and those not yet registered in the online transcript will not be considered valid for evaluation purposes.

In the event of a tie, preference will be given to the younger candidate.

Art. 7 – Application Submission

Applications must be submitted exclusively through the SOL – Studenti Online platform <https://studenti.unibo.it> by completing the following steps:

- access Studenti Online at <https://studenti.unibo.it>;
- click on the 'bandi' (calls) button;
- select **“Call for applications for the award of 30 GMAT licenses and 7 GRE licenses to deserving students in the second year of the bachelor's degree program in economics and finance (clef)”**, within the deadline indicated in Art. 8.

During the application process, candidates will be required to fill out a declaration indicating their preference between the GMAT license and the GRE license. It will not be possible to select both.

Applications submitted through any other means will not be accepted.

Candidates must verify the contact details listed in the application system.

Art. 8 - Deadline for submitting applications

Applications must be submitted by **23 February 2026 at 1:00 p.m.**

Art. 9 – Publication of the ranking list, validity, and roll-down

The ranking list will be published on the University portal where the call is posted.

The ranking list will remain valid for 3 months from the date of publication and may be used for roll-down in the event of withdrawals

Art. 10 – Acceptance of award

Awarded students must accept the license within **7** days from the receipt of the award notification, by replying to the communications sent by the administrative offices following the selection process and by providing any data required for the activation of the license.

Failure to accept within the specified deadline will result in the ranking list being rolled down.
