Call for 4 merit-based Study Awards of € 1.500 each (gross of taxes) for deserving students, enrolled in the first year of the Master's Degree in Economics and Econometrics (LM cod.5977) in the academic year 2024-2025 who, by the 15th of September 2025, have passed all first-year exams

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 30th September 2025, 12:00pm

1. OBJECT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

In order to acknowledge and reward those students enrolled in the Master's Degree in Economics and Econometrics (LM cod. 5977) in the academic year 2024-2025 and who have passed all first-year exams and earned the corresponding credits by the 15th of September 2025, LM(EC)² announces a call for 4 study awards of 1,500 € gross of taxes borne by the beneficiary and the department (1,382.49 € gross of taxes borne by the beneficiary).

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In order to apply, the following requirements must be met:

- a) Being enrolled in the first year of LM(EC)² for the first time in the A.Y. 2024-25.
- b) Having passed (and have on your records) all first-year exams by the 15th of September 2025 with a weighted average grade equal to or above **28/30**.

3. AMOUNT AND SETTLEMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS

The amount of each scholarship is 1,500 € gross of taxes borne by the beneficiary and the department (1,382.49 € gross of taxes borne by the beneficiary)

The grant does not entitle to any treatment in social security schemes.

4. APPLICATIONS

To apply for this scholarship, students must register on Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it) and click on the "Calls" section.

The application deadline is 30th September 2025, h 12 p.m. (12:00).

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Applications received after the above-mentioned deadline and time, or in alternative modes, will not be taken into consideration.

The University of Bologna can check whether the declared information corresponds to the truth. In case of false declarations, the winners will lose their right to receive the grant and will be subject to sanctions according to art. 76 DPR 445/2000.

5. EVALUATION

The Awarding Committee will be composed by three members. The scholarships will be awarded to the first four students in a ranking that will be based on the weighted average of the grades obtained in the first-year exams.

In case of equal score, the scholarship will be awarded to the youngest candidate. In case of winners' non-acceptance and/or withdrawal, the grants will be assigned to the next suitable candidates following the established ranking.

The ranking established by the Committee will be formally approved by the Head of the Department of Economics and published on the website: <https://bandi.unibo.it/> by **07 October 2025**.

6. ACCEPTANCE, RENOUNCE AND AWARDING OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarship winners will be notified by an email sent to their institutional address @studio.unibo.it and will have to confirm the **acceptance** of the scholarship **within 5 days** from the notification date, writing an email to didatticascaravilli.lmec@unibo.it.

Payment of the scholarship is conditional upon the acceptance within 5 days from the notification and to completion of the enrolment for the second year of LMEC Programme.

The scholarship winners must inform LMEC Programme Office of any change occurring with respect to what she/he has declared in her/his application. Prizes will be awarded following act of the Head of Department according to the merit-based ranking, and will be disbursed by the Department of Economics. The scholarship winners can withdraw by writing an email, not beyond the fifth day from the notification date, to the attention of the Head of the Department of Economics to didatticascaravilli.lmec@unibo.it. In this instance, the Committee can decide to award the scholarship to the next eligible candidate, following the established ranking.
