

Call for selection DSG Visiting Professor Research Project RE.S.TO.R.E. - Recovering the State Towards a Reformed Economy

Art. 1

The Alma Mater Studiorum-University of Bologna – Department of Legal Studies (hereinafter, "DSG" or "Department"), with a view to fostering the internationalization of departmental activities, adopted the present call, concerning n. 1 Visiting Fellowships for foreign highly qualified scholars, who are affiliated with non-Italian universities, invited to carry out teaching activities within the research project PRIN 2020 - RE.S.TO.R.E. - Recovering the State Towards a Reformed Economy.

In particular, the Fellowships shall allow a strong teaching interaction between invited scholar and Professors/Researchers of SSD IUS/10 - Administrative Law of the Department.

The Visiting Professor is invited to carry out teaching and seminar activities functionally included in the PRIN 2020 project - RE.S.TO.R.E. - Recovering the State Towards a Reformed Economy.

More specifically, with regard to teaching and seminar activities, the Visiting Professor: will deliver two seminar lectures on the topics of public intervention in the economy, digitization and artificial intelligence in the German legal system and in the broader European one (the lectures will be addressed to researchers of SSD IUS/10 - Administrative Law, as well as to students of Administrative Law, channel D-L); he will participate as a speaker in an important national conference on the topic of golden power, which will be held in Bologna and which is an integral part of the scientific activities of PRIN 2020 - RE.S.TO.R.E. - Recovering the State Towards a Reformed Economy.

The teaching activity must be carried out during the period **6 December 2023 – 20 December 2023**.

Art. 2

The Visiting Professor will be entitled to receive a compensation of 6.000,00 EUR (gross amount - IRAP included).

Flat-rate reimbursement will be authorized by the Department Council upon verification of the proper fulfilment of the required activities.

Art. 3

The application shall include all required documents and shall be uploaded by the candidates by **November 13st 2023 at 12:00 (CET)** on the online platform <u>https://personale.unibo.it/pol/welcome.htm?siteLanguage=en</u>.

The application shall include:

- 1. personal and professional data of the Applicant;
- 2. a scanned copy of the Applicant's passport (or other identity document) in course of validity;
- 3. Applicant's curriculum vitae et studiorum and a list of publications (last 5 years);
- 4. a short description of the programme of teaching activities to be carried out.

Visiting Professor who is not resident in EU must independently apply for a VISA.

Art. 4

The applications will be evaluated by a Commission appointed by the Department Council.

The Commission will be tasked with the selection of the best application and the definition of the final ranking list within the deadline indicated by the Council.

The selection criteria are the following:

- 1. scientific and teaching relevance;
- 2. added value for departmental activities.

For each criterion, up to 20 points can be assigned.

Only applications scoring at least 30/40 are eligible to be selected.



Art. 5

Visiting Professor will be invited through a deliberation adopted by the Department Council and containing the Professor's first and family names, contacts, dates of stay within the DSG, description of the planned activities.

The deliberation will be published on the website <u>www.dsg.unibo.it</u>.

The invitation will be formalized with a letter from the Department's Head no later than **23 November 2023.**

Within 7 days of receipt of the invitation letter, the Visiting Professor is required to formally accept the position by sending a confirmation message to: dsg.affarigenerali@unibo.it.

Art. 6

As long as the present call remains open, it will be available in the section "Calls and competition" of the website <u>https://dsg.unibo.it/en/index.html</u>.

Art. 7

All data provided will be used only for purpose connected with the selection and award of the research grant, in accordance with current regulations. In compliance with Articles 3 and 7 of Legislative Decree no. 33/2013, information, data, documents, including curriculum vitae, shall be published in an open format on the University website, section "Amministrazione Trasparente", and everyone has the right to know them, use and reuse them without restrictions, even for purposes other than this procedure, with the obligation to mention their source and to respect their integrity.
