

AREA SERVICE AREA MEDICA – NO. 6 STUDY GRANTS TO ATTEND "INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY MANAGEMENT IN MEDICAL AND PHARMACEUTICAL BIOTECHNOLOGY" SUMMER SCHOOL – 2021 CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

ART. 1 – STUDY GRANTS

This document regulates the 2021 application procedures for no. **6 study grants** of **€ 100,00** (before School tax obligations) amount each to attend the "Innovation and Technology Management In Medical And Pharmaceutical Biotechnology" Summer School for students enrolled in the Second-cycle Degree Programme of Medical Biotechnology.

The total amount of funding available for this call for applications is € 600,00 (before School tax obligations).

ART. 2 - SELECTION, PURPOSE, AND GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The study grants are aimed at applicants who, upon submitting their application, are in possession of both the following requirements:

- a) **Be currently enrolled** in Year 1 for A.Y. 2020/21 in the Second-cycle Degree Programme of Medical Biotechnology;
- b) **Be enrolled in** "Innovation and Technology Management in Medical and Pharmaceutical Biotechnology" Summer School.

The possession of both requirements will be automatically verified by our offices.

ART. 3 - APPLICATION DEADLINES AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Applications must be submitted only via the 'Studenti Online' portal by **25 June 2021 – 13:00h (Italian time).** In order to apply, candidates must:

- 1. access www.studenti.unibo.it with their institutional username and password;
- 2. click on "Calls"
- select the following call: 'Area Service Area Medica Bando per borse di studio per esperienze formative all'estero anno 2021 – Scuola di Medicina e Chirurgia, Sedi didattiche di Bologna e Imola'

Only applicants who hold the requirements outlined in art. 2 will be able to submit their application.

PLEASE NOTE that only applications submitted following the aforementioned procedure and with all the required documents will be considered; it is not possible to submit applications by email.

The following documents must be uploaded when submitting applications:

- Self-certification about personal, financial and social security information of the applicant, which must state also their chosen payment method (Attachment B);
- Copy of a valid ID.
- a) Candidates with EU citizenship may produce self-declaration statements about academic and professional qualifications according to articles 46 and 47 of Italian D.P.R. 445/2000.
- b) Candidates with non-EU citizenship who are compliant with Italian immigration rules, or who are authorised to stay on Italian territory, must follow the provisions stated in commas 2 and 3 of art. 3 of Italian D.P.R. 445/2000.

In addition to conditions a) and b) outlined above, personal statuses, individual qualities, and facts can be documented with certificates or declarations issued by the competent authority of the relevant foreign country. These certificates or declarations must be presented together with a sworn translation certified by the Italian Embassy or Consulate to be conforming to the original; before certifying conformity, the Italian Embassy or Consulate must warn the applicant about the legal consequences of producing false documents.

The University may perform background checks on candidate statements and self-declarations. In case of false declarations, applicants will be considered ineligible for the study prize, in addition to facing legal penalties pursuant of art. 76 of Italian D.P.R. 445/2000.

IMPORTANT NOTE: incomplete applications will not be considered.

ART. 4 - ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Applications will be assessed by the following Board:

- Prof. Irene Faenza (Chair);
- Prof. Giovanna Cenacchi;
- · Prof. Elena Bonora;
- Ms. Eva Brugnettini (Secretary);
- Mr. Luigi Roberto Cesi (Substitute Secretary).

Applications will be assessed by the following criteria as recorded on the official academic record by the deadline of this Call for Applications:

- 1. Weighted Average of the sat and recorded exams **up to 30 points**;
- 2. Number of recorded credits up to 60 points.

In case of a tie in score, the youngest candidate will prevail.

The final ranking and the awardees list produced by the Board will be approved with an act issued by the Head of the Medical Service Area.

ART. 5 - RANKING PUBLICATION AND GRANT ACCEPTANCE



The act by the Head of the Medical Service Area approving the final ranking and the awardees list will be published on Studenti Online; this will serve as official notice to all candidates.

Within **5** (**five**) calendar days from the ranking publication, including the day of the ranking publication applicants who have been approved **WITH a study grant ('VINCITORE')** must email their official acceptance of the study grant to sam.corsidistudio@unibo.it. Applicants who fail to notify their acceptance will lose their right to the grant.

ART. 6 - LEARNING EXPERIENCE CONFIRMATION AND GRANT

The grant will be paid upon successful attendance and completion of the "Innovation and Technology Management in Medical and Pharmaceutical Biotechnology" Summer School. Attendance and completion will be automatically verified by our offices. Should one or more grant holders fail to attend or fail the summer school, their study grant(s) will be paid to the next eligible candidate(s), according to rank.
