CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE AWARD OF A TEMPORARY CONTRACT

Art. 1 - Purpose

The Department of Political and Social Sciences announces a selection, based on work to date, for n. 1 research contract for conducting data collection and analysis on the role of courts in shaping access to asylum in Turkey.

The specific required tasks are the following:

- Compilation of Part I of the ACCESS questionnaire, mapping the barriers to access asylum in Turkey;
- Compilation of 40 casesheets on the leading Turkish jurisprudence on barriers to accessing asylum based on the template provided by the Principle Investigator (PI);
- Compilation of Part II of the ACCESS questionnaire, analyzing case law on barriers to access asylum in Turkey. The tasks must be accomplished by 28th February 2025. In accomplishing these tasks, the National Collaborator will collect about 40 relevant decisions in the Turkish jurisdiction and analyze them according to the guidelines provided by the research team. The National collaborator will propose to the PI a proposal for a list of judgments to be analyzed and they will upload the casesheets with the analysis of case law step by step;
- Compilation of Part III of the questionnaire, focusing on socio-legal factors affecting decision-making in Turkey regarding barriers-related asylum adjudication. The National Collaborator will fill out the questionnaire provided by the PI on the Turkish case based on desk research;
- Conduction of 20 interviews with crucial actors, such as judges, lawyers, NGOs, asylum seekers, involved in barriers-related asylum adjudication. The National Collaborator will be responsible for the interviews' organization, conduction, transcription, and translation in English. Moreover, they will be responsible for conducting a preliminary analysis of interviews;
- Compilation of the final report, consisting of Part I, Part II, and Part III of the ACCESS questionnaire, with updates to the first versions, integrated with findings from data collection (case law and interviews).

The activities shall be carried out mainly in remotely under the supervision of Prof. Madalina Bianca Moraru, or in the Department of Political and Social Sciences or in any other structure of the University of Bologna chosen by the participant through a non-subordinate employment relationship without a predefined working schedule.

Duration of the contract

The contract has a duration of **36 months** (about **420 hours**).

Art. 2 – Requirements for candidacy

Applicants must hold one of the following Master's degree: Information and Publishing Systems; International Relations; Economics; Advertising and Communication for the Public and Private Sectors; Political Science; Public Administration; Development co-operation; Methods and techniques for the information society; Law.

Candidates who have completed the aforementioned degree abroad may also apply, if said degree is recognized as equivalent to Italian degrees. To this end, candidates must attach to the application form a declaration of equivalence of their degree to Italian degrees issues by relevant authority. In case it is not possible to attach such declaration, candidates must translate the diploma obtained and declare that the translation correspond to the original version.

If the winner obtained the qualification in a non-EU Country, will have to send to the Department the official translation with declaration of value issued by the Italian diplomatic or consular representations in the country of origin before stipulating the contract.

Additional competence and/or experience requested:

- 1. Minimum 12 months of experience about migration, system asylum in Turkey, International Refugee Law, EU rights of asylum;
- 2. Mother tongue/C1 level in English; preferably knowledge of Turkish to be proved by certification issued by Cultural Institutes or by University certificate reporting exams taken in that language would be a relevant asset in the selection process;
- 3. Not being guilty of any criminal convictions and/or pending criminal proceedings that are incompatible with the duties to be performed;
- 4. Enjoyment of civil and political rights.

The selection is not open to any persons who are related by blood or by marriage up to the fourth degree, to a professor working in the department or structure for which the call is issued, or to the Rector, Director General or a member of the Board of Governors of the University.

Art. 3 - University of Bologna employees

University of Bologna employees can participate to the call for application. In case they are going to be successful, they will not receive additional remuneration.

Art. 4 - Application procedure

Candidates with all the aforementioned requisites who wish to participate in the selection process must submit within Monday October, 7 2024:

- the application form, based on the attached models, filled on plain paper and signed;
- the photocopy (non-authenticated) of a valid identification document; a curriculum vitae containing a detailed description of the studies and professional experience, as well as any other information or experience that the candidate believes may be useful to the evaluation of her/his application, dated and signed.
- translation of their diploma, if needed.

In order to submit the application and documentation listed above, candidates can send the application form and related documentation:

- by priority mail or courier to the Department of Political and Social Sciences, Strada Maggiore 45, 40125, Bologna. In this case, it is recommended to write on the envelope "Call Ref. n. 337 to Andrea Rossetti".

Art. 5 – Comparative assessment of the candidates and the Evaluation Board

The candidates will be assessed by an Evaluation Board appointed by the Department composed of at least three members qualified in the field of research to which the call for applications refers.

The categories of qualifications listed in Annex 5 can be assessed. The overall score cannot exceed 40.

A t the end of the procedure, the commission will form a ranking that will last 5 months.

Art. 6 - Remuneration

The gross amount of the research contract is \in 6.550,00 including tax and social charge contribution. The amount will be paid in quarterly installment.
