Call for Selection of students enrolled in the master's degree courses in Scienze Internazionali e Diplomatiche, International Politics and Markets, MIREES, MASS MEDIA E POLITICA a.y. 2020/2021 for the training course in Design Thinking

Art. 1 - Purpose

The Department of Political and Social Sciences of the Alma Mater Studiorum-University of Bologna, Strada Maggiore 45, Bologna, announces a selection, based on qualifications, for the allocation of a total of 30 places for students enrolled for the A.Y. 2020/21 in the second year of the master's degree courses of the Department of Political and Social Sciences, Forlì Campus, to participate in the Design Thinking training that will take place online from Friday 18 to Thursday 24 June 2021. The training, organized in collaboration with Fondazione Golinelli, aims at acquiring professional skills through the Design Thinking approach. Through this approach, participants are stimulated to creative thinking aimed at problem solving and decision making. Design Thinking is an approach made up of a set of methods and tools, which aims to solve complex problems relating to users, empathizing with them, understanding their needs and real problems, exploring the entire context in question with a constant attitude to research.

The training is articulated in a process through which this approach is explained and experimented, starting from a challenge to be solved that has been identified among the topics studied by the students involved. The course will be held in English.

Art. 2 - Application Requirements

Candidates in possession of the following requirements may participate in the selection process:

1. enrollment in the second year of the master's degree courses "Scienze Internazionali e Diplomatiche", "International Politics and Markets", "MIREES", "Mass Media e Politica";
2. B2 certification of the English language. For those enrolled in the courses "Scienze Internazionali e Diplomatiche", "International Politics and Markets" and "MIREES" the requirement is considered satisfied and does not require certification. For those enrolled in the "Mass Media e Politica" course, the certification must be attached according to the equivalence table of the Centro Linguistico di Ateneo available at the following web address:

Art. 3 – Application

The application must be submitted exclusively online through the University's Studenti Online (SOL) application, from May 7, 2021 1:00 p.m. 2021 to May 27, 2021 1:00 p.m. (local time).

To use the application you must:

1. access <https://studenti.unibo.it/>, using your University credentials;
2. click on the “Calls” button;
3. select the "Call for Selection for the participation of students enrolled in the Master's degree courses in Scienze Internazionali e Diplomatiche, International Politics and Markets, MIREES, MASS MEDIA E POLITICA. a.y. 2020/2021 in the Design Thinking training".

The application must be made on the appropriate form attached to this call (Annex 1).

Applicants, under penalty of exclusion, must attach the following documents:

- 1) photocopy of a valid identification document;
- 2) Certificate of knowledge of the English language (at least level B2) (except for those enrolled in the courses "Scienze Internazionali e Diplomatiche", "International Politics and Markets" and "MIREES", in accordance with the provisions of art. 2, point 2, of this call);
- 3) Curriculum vitae containing any previous training and international mobility experiences.

The Department reserves the right to perform ad hoc checks to verify the truthfulness of the provided information.

Art. 4 - Comparative evaluation of the candidates and Evaluation Committee

Applicants will be evaluated by an Evaluation Committee appointed by the Department.

The evaluation committee will formulate the ranking based on the following criteria.

- academic merit: up to 70 points
- further training acquired: up to 30 points (Erasmus, other courses, etc.).

There are no minimum eligibility thresholds for admission.

Candidates are not expected to be present during the evaluation of qualifications.

At the end of the selection process, the Commission will draw up a ranking of merit. The ranking will be published on the website of the Department of Political and Social Sciences at the page: <http://www.dsps.unibo.it/it>, section "Bandi", "Bandi di varie tipologie".
