## Introduction

This specialized courses will be in the form of a Workshop on a topic, including both lectures and tutorials offered by the local teachers and by some distinguished guest experts.

All participants will obtain a certificate of attendance and a successful accomplishment of the course is worthy 6 ECTS that can be acknowledged within the Master program.

These courses are a unique opportunity to take part in an international event, to learn a specialized topic in finance in depth, to work in contact with an important companies and to experiment professional group work in a selected multinational team.

This call aims to select 24 students who will be allowed to take part in one of the following IP:

**Advanced Topics in Energy Market and Finance** (Alma Mater Studiorum Università di Bologna)

**Advanced Topics in Asset Management** (University of Applied Sciences BFI Vienna)

**Advanced Topics in Risk Management** (University of Economics in Katowice)

**Advanced Topics in Bank Risk Management** (Alexandru Ioan Cuza University of Iași)

## Eligibility

Students enrolled for academic year 2021/22 in the first or second year of the Master Degree in Quantitative Finance at the University of Bologna are entitled to apply to this call, in order to participate to one of the Advanced Topics.

## Grants

Participation in the Intensive Programme is free of charge.

Nine grants are available for QF students who will be selected to take part in one of the Advanced Topics abroad.

The amount of each grant is equal to 600 € each (gross amount).

Students will receive the grant after the attendance at the Advanced Topics. Once back, they will have to send a certificate of attendance and a self - declaration stating that the student has attended the Advanced Topics **in presence** at [marialuigia.loiudice@unibo.it](mailto:marialuigia.loiudice@unibo.it)

This scholarship is incompatible with other grants for international mobility provided by the University of Bologna during the same period.

## Evaluation criteria

Candidates will be selected based on the following criteria:

- academic merit (up to 50 points);
- motivation (up to 25 points);
- English language (up to 25 points).

All candidates will be acknowledged with a B2 level (no certificates are required). Certificates stating a higher level will be taken into account and will grant a higher score.

In case of equal scores, the grant will be provided to the younger candidate.

### **ART. 5 How to submit the application**

Applications to take part in this competition must reach the administration office **by and no later than 12.00 on 7 December**, solely via the Studenti Online app.

To use the app you need to:

1. access [www.studenti.unibo.it](http://www.studenti.unibo.it) entering your university credentials;
2. click on “Calls for applications”;
3. select the call for applications you are interested in: **Unibo call for applications for the selection of students enrolled on the “Quantitative Finance” master's degree for academic year 2021-2022, to participate in one of the Intensive Programmes.**

To participate in the call for applications candidates must attach the following documents in pdf format:

1. Application form
2. Motivation letter (max. one page)
3. Front and back copy of a valid identification document (ID card, passport)
4. English Language certification (only if you have a higher level than a B2)

### **ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE UPLOADED IN PDF FORMAT.**

**The application will be deemed valid only if the student completes the procedure shown above, complete with the requested documentation. It will not be possible to send the application to the offices in paper format or by email.**

**The complete application, with all requested documentation, must reach the Administration office by and no later than the deadline stated in this call for applications. The administration office accepts no responsibility if an application fails to arrive by the stated deadline or if it is incomplete.**
