Grants for deserving 2nd year students of the Master's Degree Program in Statistical Sciences (CLAMSS) Academic Year 2023/2024

APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 18th, 2024

The Department of Statistical Sciences will grant 5 scholarships to students properly enrolled in the second year of the Master's Degree Program in Statistical Sciences for the Academic Year 2023/2024.

Each scholarship amounts to $\ensuremath{\mathfrak{C}}$ 2.000 gross of taxes. The scholarship is granted for one academic year.

Eligibility

Grants are reserved to students enrolling in the 2nd year of Laurea Magistrale in Statistical Sciences (CLAMSS) for the A.Y. 2023/2024 who have completed at least of 60 CFU and have an average mark equal to or greater than 26/30 before the call deadline.

The call for the application will open on January 25th, 2024.

How to submit the application

Applications to take part in this competition must reach the administration office by no later than March 18th, 2024, 12:00 solely via the Studenti Online application. In the "calls" section of the Studenti Online page, select: "Bando per l'assegnazione di 5 borse di studio per studenti meritevoli regolarmente iscritti al secondo anno del Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Statistical Sciences per l'anno accademico 2023/24".

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: You must attach a Curriculum vitae in European format, dated, and signed in PDF format, under penalty of exclusion from the competition. All requested documents must be attached in PDF format.

Selection

Grants will be granted by the Admission Board based on the admission ranking. Only students who meet the eligibility requirements will be considered (see section "Eligibility"). In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal results in the ranking, the grant will be awarded to the candidate with greater number of honors and younger age.

Grants will be assigned based on the admission ranking, starting with the first admitted student and going down to the second. If one of the students fails to accept the grant and/or declines the grant, the grant is granted to the student who comes next in the ranking.

The admission ranking is based on criteria which take into consideration:

- Number of CFU achieved before the deadline of this call. (from 1 to 6 points)
- Average mark of registered exams before the deadline. (from 1 to 6 points)
- Certified study mobility experiences abroad undertaken during the enrolment period in the Master's Degree Program in Statistical Sciences and concluded by the deadline of this call (up to 1 point);
- Certified internship experience during the enrolment period in the Master's Degree Program in Statistical Sciences concluded by the deadline of this call (up to 1 point);
- Certified working experience during the enrolment period in the Master's Degree Program in Statistical Sciences related to the study field. (up to 1 point)

Any study mobility experiences abroad, internships, and work experiences must be included and described in detail in the curriculum; for each of these experiences, the duration must also be indicated. In the absence of such information, the number of points attributed to these criteria will be 0.

Acceptance

Students who are selected for the grant will be informed by e-mail at the Unibo institutional email address. Within 10 days from the reception of the news about the award of the grant, candidates should send an email to cdl.clamss@unibo.it using the institutional student email account and state that he/she accepts the grant at the terms stated in this procedure, without further conditions. Failure to the accept the grant is tantamount to declining it.

Payment

The payment will take place by means by in one of the following methods:

- Bank wire transfer to an account in the name of the beneficiary, with IBAN in the SEPA
- Bank wire transfer to a rechargeable reloadable prepaid card, with IBAN code, in the name of the beneficiary.
- Bank wire transfer to an account in the name of the beneficiary outside the SEPA area, with commissions fully borne by the beneficiary (commissions will be charged to the recipient).

Incompatibility with other grants

The grant is compatible with other financial grants that may be/have been obtained by the beneficiary, unless the incompatibility is attached to these stated for the other financial grants that the student may have been awarded.

The grant is NOT compatible with "Grants for 2nd year students of the Master's Degree Program in Statistical Sciences (CLAMSS) Academic Year 2023/2024 (Application deadline: March 7th, 2024)".

Students should check whether other grants they benefit are not compatible with the grant awarded by the Department of Statistical Sciences. In such a case, they should opt choose for one type of grant or the other.

Declining the grant or losing of the grant

Students who intend to decline the grant should send an e-mail to <u>cdl.clamss@unibo.it</u> using the institutional student email account. If a student declines the grant or if missing banking information is discovered, the grant it will be assigned to the next following student in the selection ranking.
