Introduction

The *GrEnFIn-Summer School and Training* will consist of two online meetings (June 4th and 5th 2024) and an onsite residency in Bertinoro (from June 23rd to 27th 2024), which will include both lectures and tutorials.

All participants will obtain a certificate of attendance and a successful accomplishment of the course is worthy 6 ECTS that can be acknowledged within the Master program.

This summer school is a unique opportunity to take part in an international event, to learn a specialized topic in finance in depth, to work in contact with important companies and to experiment professional group work in a selected multinational team.

This call aims to select 20 students who will be allowed to take part in the *GrEnFIn-Summer School and Training*.

Eligibility

Students enrolled for the academic year 2023/2024 in the first or second year of the Master Degree in *Greening Energy Market and Finance* and in *Quantitative Finance* at the University of Bologna are eligible for applying to this call.

Participation in the Summer School is free of charge. The department of Statistical Sciences will pay the costs of food and accommodation to the 20 selected students.

At the end of the Summer School, the students will have to send a certificate of attendance and a self - declaration stating that the student has attended the Summer School <u>in presence</u> at <u>angelo.neri6@unibo.it</u>

Evaluation criteria

Candidates will be selected based on the following criteria:

- academic merit (up to 50 points);
- motivation (up to 25 points);
- English language (up 25 points).

All candidates will be acknowledged with a B2 level (no certificates are required). Certificates stating a higher level will be taken into account and will grant a higher score.

In case of equal scores, the grant will be provided to the younger candidate.



How to submit the application

Applications to take part in this competition must reach the administration office by and no later than

To participate in the call for applications candidates must attach the following documents in pdf format:

- 1. Application form
- 2. Transcript of records (with the exams of the master degree)
- 3. Motivation letter (max. one page)
- 4. Front and back copy of a valid identification document (ID card, passport)
- 5. English Language certification (only if you have a higher level than a B2)

ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE UPLOADED IN PDF FORMAT.

The application will be deemed valid only if the student completes the procedure shown above, complete with the requested documentation. It will not be possible to send the application to the offices in paper format or by email.

The complete application, with all requested documentation, must reach the Administration office by and no later than the deadline stated in this call for applications. The administration office accepts no responsibility if an application fails to arrive by the stated deadline or if it is incomplete.
